1. **September 2023:** Award Committees selected by Deans

\*The Deans must approve any changes to the award criteria prior to the solicitation of nominees for the award.

**November 2023:** Nominations Open

<u>February 9, 2024:</u> The Nomination Form, with accompanying documentation, must be submitted to the Chair of the nominee's department

<u>February 16, 2024:</u> The Nomination Form, with accompanying documentation, must be submitted to the Dean of the nominee's college

<u>February 23, 2024:</u> The Nomination Form, with accompanying documentation, must be submitted to the Office of Academic Affairs via email with PDF attachment.
