Academic Scholarships

Minimum 3.0 gpa on high school core curriculum

Renewable for 7 additional continuous semesters, excluding summer
To be considered for an academic scholarship, simply apply for admission to UNA. When all of your academic credentials (high school transcript, ACT scores, etc.) are on record at UNA, you will be considered automatically for academic scholarships.

Valedictorian & Salutatorian Scholarships

\$2,800/year

Renewable for 7 additional continuous semesters, excluding summer
Apply for admission to UNA and submit a letter from your high school documenting your status as valedictorian or salutatorian of your graduating class. Minimum 18 ACT required.

Leadership Scholarships

Minimum 2.75 gpa on high school core curriculum;
18+ ACT & leadership points based on submitted résumé.
From \$1,200/year to Full Tuition**

Renewable for 7 additional continuous semesters, excluding summer
These competitive scholarships are awarded to students who have demonstrated strong leadership in high school and who have potential as campus leaders at UNA. Outstanding high school seniors whose ACT score is at least an 18 and whose high school core gpa is at least a 2.75 may apply. Please submit a résumé of all activities performed in high school grades 9-12.

* Full tuition for up to 16 hours. Award does not include fees (including nonresident fees/tuition) and other charges.

** Full-tuition for up to 16 hours. Award does not include books, fees, (including nonresident fees/tuition) and other charges.

*** Applications received after February 1 will be awarded on a funds-available basis only.

+ Participation in the UNA Honors Program.

Regional Scholarships

For non-residents only;

minimum 2.75 gpa on high school core curriculum & 18 ACT
From \$1,200/year to full non-resident fee*

Renewable for 7 additional continuous semesters, excluding summer
High school seniors from outside Alabama and outside the eleven counties UNA considers "in-state" (Mississippi and Tennessee) are considered eligible for these scholarships. No additional forms are required. Apply for admission to UNA and submit a written request for consideration.

* Full non-resident fee for up to 16 hours. Award does not include fees and other charges.

Presidential Mentors Academy

The candidate must be a resident of the state of Alabama or reside in one of the eleven contiguous counties in TN or MS which UNA considers "in-state." The candidate must be admitted unconditionally.

Renewable for 7 additional continuous semesters, excluding summer
UNA supports opportunities for students whose racial group is underrepresented on the UNA campus. The PMA provides living/learning experiences for incoming minority freshmen students. The program combines academic success with financial assistance and on campus work opportunities for qualifying entering freshman students. The successful candidate must possess both leadership potential and the potential to succeed in a higher education environment as demonstrated by a résumé of high school activities and a written recommendation from the high school principal, counselor, or teacher.

Charles N. Martin, Jr. Scholarship

Minimum 2.25 gpa on high school core curriculum;

18 - 25 ACT & letter of recommendation from high school counselor
Amount of scholarship varies

Renewable for 7 additional continuous semesters, excluding summer
This scholarship is for students who attend county high schools in Colbert, Lauderdale, Franklin, Lawrence, Limestone, Madison, Cullman, Jackson, Marion, Morgan, Walker, and Winston counties in Alabama; Alcorn, Benton, Itawamba, Marshall, Prentiss, and Tishomingo counties in Mississippi; and Giles, Hardin, Lawrence, McNairy, and Wayne counties in Tennessee. Submit a letter of recommendation from your guidance counselor stating that you are applying for the Charles N. Martin, Jr. Scholarship and that there is a financial need for this scholarship.

Special Notes on Excellence Scholarships

- As a rule, a student may receive no more than one UNA Excellence Scholarship.
- An eligible student must be accepted for unconditional admission and submit all specified credentials by **February 1, 2008**, to be considered for any Excellence scholarship.
- All scholarship awards are subject to the availability of funds and specific terms and conditions of the scholarship offer letter and associated attachments.
- Excellence scholarships are for new freshmen entering UNA immediately after graduation from high school.
- Only U.S. citizens are eligible.
