

Venetian Blinds Make Library Reading Easy

Early in January the windows in the library were equipped with Venetian blinds, five double and eight single, each about twelve feet long.

According to Miss Myrtle Emerson, librarian, these blinds keep out the glare, yet do not darken the library and many students have remarked upon the cheerfulness of the reading room since the installation of the shades.

Equipment yet to come are golden oak shelves for reference books which will be placed between the windows.
