A minor in library science will be added to the college curriculum in the Spring quarter.

Emphasis in the library science academic offerings will be on preparing teacher-librarians for the schools of the area, but students will be prepared to enter graduate schools of library science with full credit.

Miss Schmitt will offer three courses in the Spring quarter: Books and Related Material for Children and Young People (201), Organization and Administration of School Library Service (341), and The Library in the School (241).

The associate professor will also be available as a consultant for inservice librarians and student teachers.
