Miss Emerson Stresses Library Requirements

The college library which contains over 23,000 volumes, is located on the second floor of Bibb Graves Hall, and will seat 160 people. Over 150 magazines are received each month, together with the Readers Guide to Periodicals, Education Index, Book Review Digest, and Cumulative Book Index, and numerous newspapers.

The library will be open from 8 A. M. to 9:30 P. M. each day of the week except Saturday, when the hours will be from 8 A. M. to 12 M.

Non-reserve books may be checked for a period of one week, subject to a fine of two cents for each day overdue.

Reserve books, those selected by the instructors for special class reading, are to be used for one hour in the library, and are subject to a fine of five cents per hour when kept overtime. Reserve books may be checked at 9:15 P. M. and must be returned by 8 o'clock the following morning. On Saturday, reserve books will be checked at 10 A. M.

No current magazines or bound periodicals may be taken from the library.

The library is a place for quiet and study. All talking, other than asking the librarians for books, is prohibited. Conferences and studying with another person must be done outside the library, according to Miss Emerson, accommodating and efficient librarian.
