Collier Library Makes Changes, Adds Librarian

Collier Library has announced several changes which are important to the students.

All students are to sign all book cards at the desk placed at the door leading into the stacks. Books are to be stamped to the circulation desk, and are to be checked out before they are taken from the stacks. Faculty members are to sign their book cards at the circulation desk. During the hours from 12:00 to 1:00 and 4:00 to 7:00 all books are to be checked out from the circulation desk.

The desk was placed at the door leading into the stacks to to prevent the loss of books, for during the previous school year 461 books were missing in inventory. This is an estimated loss of \$200,000 in books.

Periodicals formerly found in the reading room, browsing room and on reserve are now located on the second floor. The stairway leading to the third level stacks has been closed and this level can be entered only from the second floor.

A circulation librarian, Miss Viola Sheats, has been added to the library staff. She can be found at the circulation desk and will help the students in locating material and information.
