

Ruth Tarbox To Address Librarians

A nationally recognized authority in the field of library science will speak at the eleventh annual fall conference on school library service at Florence State College on Wednesday, November 6.

The speaker, Miss Ruth Tarbox of Chicago, is Director of School and Library Services of World Book, Field Enterprises Educational Corporation. She is active in State and National Library Associations and has contributed numerous articles on library service to professional journals.

Miss Tarbox will be making her second fall appearance on the Florence State campus. Last year she spoke to students of the Department of Library Science.

The annual workshop is sponsored jointly by the college and District VIII, Alabama School Librarians Association. It will be attended by more than 300 librarians, student librarians, principals and teachers from the area schools.
