IMPROVEMENTS IN COLLEGE LIBRARY MADE IN TERM

Two English Weeklies And N. Y. Times New Periodicals

Several additions have been made to the library during the fall quarter, including equipment and reading material:

New steel stacks have been installed in the back of the room and will house approximately 2,500 volumes.

A new section to the card catalog has been placed in the reading room and a new section to the shelf list, in the library office.

At the beginning of the fall quarter over 160 American and English periodicals were subscribed for. Newspapers include The New York Times, London Times, Manchester Guardian, and Christian Science Monitor, as well as a good number of local and state papers.

The library has just received the Encyclopedia of Social Sciences. Other important reference books have been ordered and will include the Oxford English Dictionary.

Large book orders for the training school and college libraries have been placed and the books will be here by the first of the year.

Seventy-seven volumes of bound periodicals were received from the bindery early in the quarter.
