

New Science Building Planned; Library Addition Will Be Built

Architects are working on the final plans for a \$718,000 science and home economics building which is the fourth in an expansion program of eight buildings on the Florence State College campus. The total project will cost approximately \$3,300,000 when it is completed.

Located just across the street from the new men's dormitory, which is now under construction, the three-story structure will resemble other additions to the campus with its concrete frame and brick face.

Library Addition

Plans are also nearing completion on another three-story building which will be erected on the campus. An addition to Collier Library, which will cost in the neighborhood of \$400,000, will be air-conditioned and will accommodate approximately 158,000 volumes. This will help alleviate the need for space for stacks and seating which is now a problem in the structure which was built in 1939.

Additional Librarian Hired

The 60,000 volume Collier Library had 94,109 visitors last year, who checked out 32,143 materials for home use. An additional assistant librarian was employed this year as circulation manager on the college library

staff to help accommodate the large number of visitors.

Northington, Smith and Krarnert, the architectural firm that designed the two buildings, are in the process of making final adjustments to their drawings.

Bids for the contract for these new buildings should be advertised next semester.

new project are a laboratory school, which will replace Kilby Training School, an auditorium, and a fine arts building.

Under construction now as a part of the \$3,300,000 expansion program are a men's dormitory, a student union buildings, and a women's dormitory. They are scheduled to be completed next semester and will cost \$1,365,000.
