

# Collier to stay open until 2 a.m.

Collier Library will soon be keeping longer hours thanks to a resolution approved by The University of North Alabama's Executive Council.

The Student Government Association presented the Executive Council with a proposal to open Collier Library both earlier and later throughout the week. The Executive Council then approved the SGA's resolution.

The library hours are in the process of being extended to 2 a.m. Sunday through Thursday nights.

According to Dr. Garry Warren, Dean of Information Technologies, the new hours will be going into effect "as soon as we can get people hired."

Warren said they were in the process of hiring two library clerks, two library assistants (who would be students), and one campus security personnel.

The additional library personnel will help in manning the periodicals and circulation desks.

Warren said that while later they "may add another hour on Friday afternoon and maybe an hour earlier on Sunday," that priority number one was to get the building open until 2 a.m.

All library facilities will be available when Collier Library goes to its new hours except for the Computer Center.

According to Warren the campus network is backed up at 1 a.m. and so the Computer Center will have to close at that time.
