

# **Miss Ruth Dacus Announces Liberal Library Policy**

As a result of a recent study of periodical circulation at ten colleges, we should like to announce the following changes in our circulation policy for periodicals on a trial basis:

Effective January 4, 1954 — For both faculty and students —

Magazines, bound or unbound may be checked out for overnight use at 9:00 pm to be returned by 8:10 the following morning (Monday through Thursday). On Friday, they may be checked out at 4:00 pm to be returned by 8:10 Saturday morning. For week-end use, they may be checked out at noon on Saturday to be returned by 8:10 Monday morning. Both faculty and students may continue

to take them out for a class period to be returned at the end of the period.

Fines will be the same as for reserve books — 5c an hour or any part of an hour.

These changes seem to comply with those of some of the most lenient of the libraries studied regarding periodical regulations.
