

Why Early College/ Dual Credit at UNA?

- **Fixed Tuition Rate**

UNA has agreed to a fixed tuition rate of \$375 per course for up to two courses a semester for a period of 3 years.

- **Dual Credit**

UNA offers eligible students the opportunity to earn high school credit and college credit simultaneously.

- **Scholarship**

Students who complete 12 semester hours of dual enrollment courses at UNA and maintain a 3.0 GPA will be eligible for a \$1,000 (\$500 per semester) scholarship. Students who complete 17 semester hours or more of dual enrollment courses at UNA and maintain a 3.0 GPA will be eligible for a \$1,500 (\$750 per semester) scholarship. These scholarships are stackable up to the cost of attendance.

- **Academic Support**

Early College students will have a dedicated academic advisor, as well as access to all academic support services available to UNA students.

- **Student Engagement**

Early College students will be presented with the opportunity to attend events on UNA's campus and be provided a UNA Mane Card.

- **College Readiness Course**

First semester Early College students will enroll in a FREE one-credit-hour college readiness course designed to facilitate a seamless transition from high school to college. It will include topics like study skills, time management, and career exploration. If successfully completed, the course will substitute for FYE 101 - First Year Experience.

- **Online Course Rotation**

UNA has provided its partner schools with a rotation of when Early College and dual credit courses will be offered online during fall, spring, and summer so that students can plan to participate in those courses in advance.
