TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIPS

Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship - \$4,500/year

- ▶ Minimum 3.25 GPA
- ▶ Minimum 30 Transferrable Credit Hours
- ▶ Must be transferring from a two-year community college

Community College Scholarship - \$2,500/year

- ▶ Minimum 3.00 GPA
- ▶ Minimum 30 Transferrable Credit Hours
- ▶ Must be transferring from a two-year community college

Opportunity Transfer Scholarship - \$1,500/year

- ▶ Minimum 2.00 GPA
- ▶ Minimum 30 Transferrable Credit Hours
- ▶ Must be a first-time Transfer Student
