TUITION AND FEES

TUITION FOR UNDERGRADUATE CREDIT:

Studentsenrollingforundergraduatecredit, remedial courses, or who audit undergraduate courses will pay tuition of \$153.00 per enrolled hour.

TUITION FOR GRADUATE CREDIT:

Students taking courses for graduate creditor who audit graduate courses will pay tuition of \$196.00 per enrolled hour.

NONRESIDENT TUITION:

Undergraduates tudents who are not Alabamares idents for tuition purposes, as determined by the University, will pay, in addition to all other tuition and fees, a nonresident tuition of \$153.00 per enrolled hour.

Graduate students who are not Alabama residents for tuition purposes, as determined by the University, will pay, in addition to all other tuition and fees, a nonresident tuition of \$196.00 per enrolled hour.

Residents of Alcorn, Itawamba, Prentiss, and Tishomingo counties in Mississippi and residents of Decatur, Giles, Harbin, Lawrence, McNairy, and Wayne counties in Tennessee will be allowed to attend the University at the same tution rate assessed to in-state students.

TECHNOLOGY FEE

Each student will pay \$12.00 per enrolled hour. (Includes courses taken for audit.)

HEALTH FEE

The fee is \$40.00 per term.

RECREATIONAL FACILITY FEE

Therecreational facility fee is charged at the rate of \$9.00 per enrolled hour with a maximum charge of \$108.00 per term.

STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE

The fee is \$25.00 per term.

FACILITIES FFF

The facilities fee is charged at the rate of \$9.00 per enrolled hour.

ON-LINE MBA COURSES

Students taking courses through the On-Line MBA Program will pay \$936.00 per course, plus a \$60.00 distance learning fee.

CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES

Continuing Education Courses for university credit will be charged at \$153.00 per enrolled hour plus applicable fees.

MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION

There is a \$32.00 charge per a cademic year for each vehicle registered. All students parking vehicles on campus are required to display a current parking decal. Decals are automatically issued to registered students. Additional permits or first time permits is sued in the spring or summer terms will be prorated (\$20.00 in the spring and \$10.00 in the summer).
