- All application materials must be submitted and reviewed prior to being scheduled for an interview
 with the Counselor Education Faculty. The admission interview is the final step in the application
 process.
- Required **application materials** include the following:
 - Undergraduate transcripts from degree-conferring institutions and transcripts for all graduate work. Candidates who have completed an advanced degree or whose undergraduate GPA is 3.0 or above are NOT required to submit test scores.
 - Test score—the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) or the Miller Analogies Test (MAT).
 - Applicants with less than a 3.0 GPA may be admitted based on the sliding scale in the table below.
 - Applicants who do not have the required GPA/Test scores in the table below, may be eligible for conditional admission with the following scores: 388/MAT or GRE 146/verbal and 140/quantitative.  - Three Recommendation for Admission forms completed by current/former supervisors or instructors. This form is available through the online application system.
 - Resume, including educational background, a record of employment and volunteer activities.
