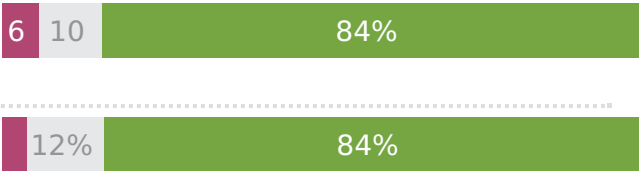

- 1. My teacher is a very good listener when kids talk to her/him.



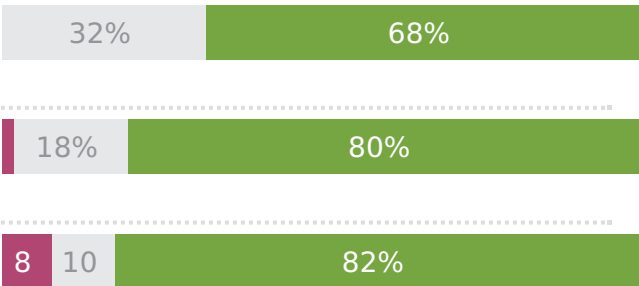
Captivate

- 1. I like the things we are learning in this class.

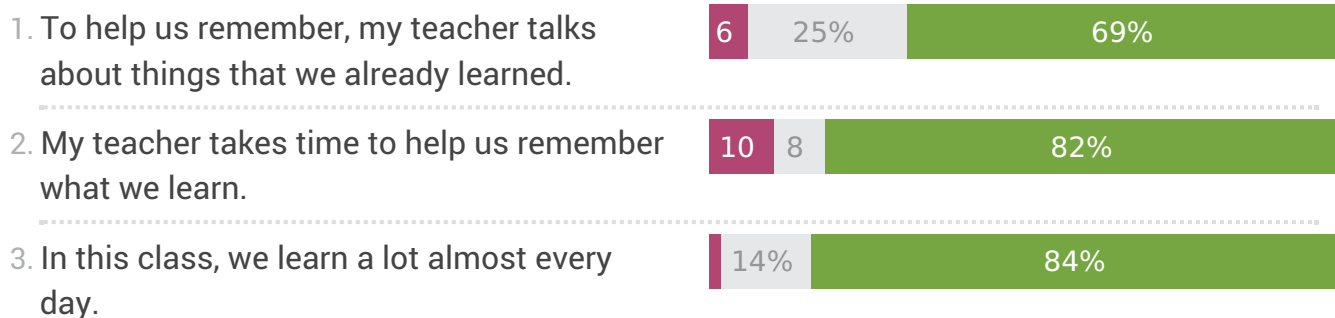

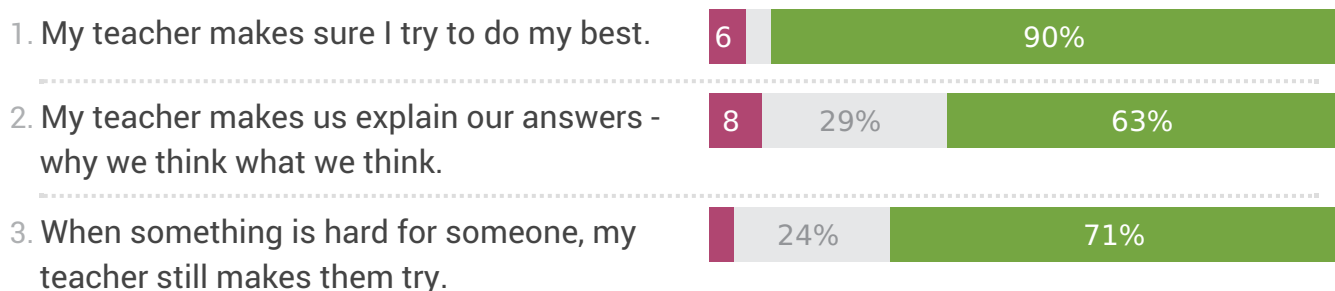
- 1. My teacher is very good at explaining things.

- 3. When he/she is teaching us, my teacher asks us whether we understand.



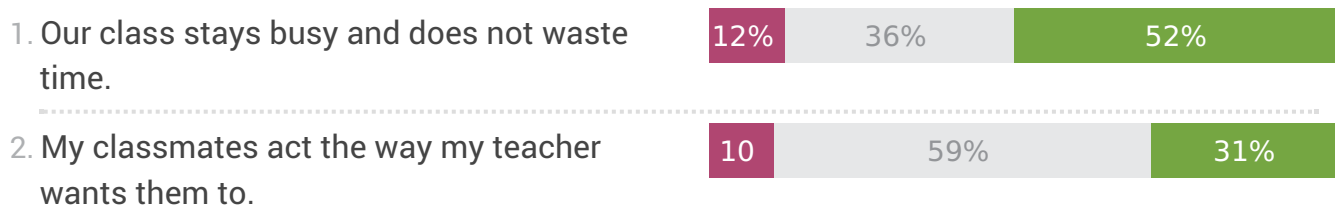

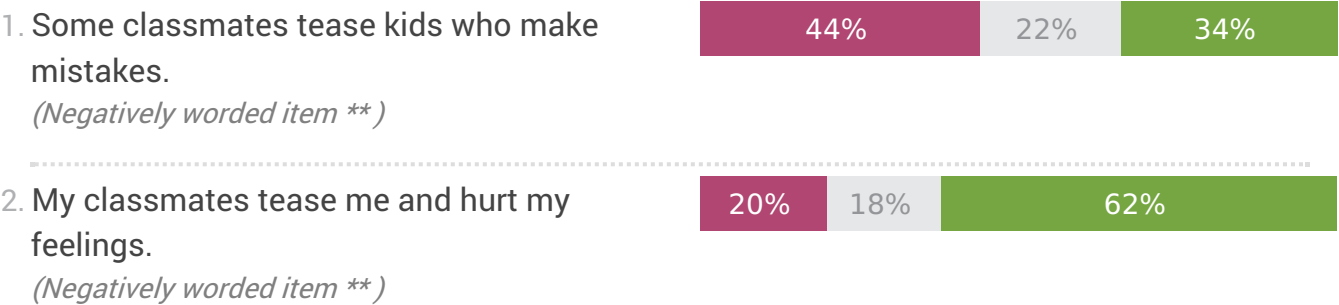
