- Attend mandatory monthly meetings – second Monday of each month at 7:15 am
- Not be involved in student teaching or an internship during the year commitment
- Be in good standing with the university and free of any disciplinary actions
- Be able to communicate effectively both orally and in writing with a diverse group of people and personalities
- Be able to visually explore the campus with visitors and help with the recruitment of undergraduates
- Be available for service assignments at daytime, evening, and weekend events
- Attend the scheduled meetings, retreats, and mandatory events
- Demonstrate a strong level of commitment to programs and initiatives within the COEHS and UNA through student participation and leadership
