The Department of Geography at the University of North Alabama invites applications for a full-time tenure-track faculty position, at the rank of assistant professor, in **Human Geography with a focus on Sustainability** effective August 2014. Applicants with a strong quantitative and applied GIS and Technology (GIS&T) background are preferred. We see opportunities for further strengthening our graduate and undergraduate programs in several areas including: urban and regional planning; urban geography, nature and society interactions; and economic geography. The successful candidate will develop and teach a new graduate course in sustainability and also teach introductory and upper level Geography courses. Teaching load is four (4) classes per semester. Applicants must have a Ph.D. in Geography by the date of appointment. The successful candidate will be expected to advise undergraduate and graduate students. UNA expects faculty to be enthusiastic, energetic, collegial and student-centered. Excellence in teaching, research, and service are required for tenure and promotion.
