Area(s) of Emphasis (42 credit hours)

Requirements for a single emphasis:

- No more than 24 hours can be taken within the same discipline.
- A minimum of 24 hours of 300/400 level credit must be included in the area of emphasis (36 total needed to graduate).
- No more than 30 hours may come from SCOBT.
- A writing-intensive course ("W") must be included.
- Up to 12 hours of advisor-approved classes may be included contingent upon their alignment with the student's career goals.

Requirements for two areas of emphasis:

- Each emphasis will be 21 credit hours.
- Each emphasis will include a minimum of 12 hours of 300/400 level credit (36 total needed to graduate).
- No more than 24 hours can be taken within the same discipline.
- No more than 30 hours may come from SCOBT.
- A writing-intensive course ("W") must be included in one emphasis.
- Up to 6 hours of advisor-approved classes that fall outside of either area of emphasis may be included contingent upon their alignment with the student's career goals.
