**Within the area of emphasis:** students must complete a minimum of 24 hours at the 300/400 level (36 total hours of 300/400 level classes are needed to graduate). No more than 24 credit hours can come from a single academic discipline. All students must complete a writing-intensive course ("W"). A 2.0 minimum GPA is required.
