

## MATHEMATICA for Students

1. Go to [user.wolfram.com](https://user.wolfram.com):
  1. New users who do NOT already have a WolframID will need to use the link at the bottom of the box which says "Don't have a Wolfram ID?" and click on "Create one."
  2. Users who already have a WolframID may skip to section 2 below.
  3. Fill out form using your @una.edu email only (**gmail or other email addresses will not work**)
  4. Click "Create Wolfram ID"
  5. Check your email and click the link to validate your WolframID
