Audition Requirements

- Woodwind, Brass, Strings: one prepared piece, or two brief works of contrasting style; scales/arpeggios; sight reading
- Percussion: 1 short solo on each - concert snare drum, timpani, and keyboard percussion; 3 chromatically adjacent major scales; required rudimental etude (email imoyer@una.edu for a copy)
- Piano: two or more works of contrasting style; may also require scales/arpeggios; sight reading
- Voice: two contrasting, accompanied selections from the classical, musical theater or jazz genres, (one in Italian, German or French encouraged but not required); pitch matching; sight-reading.
