- Woodwind, Brass, Strings: one prepared piece, or two brief works of contrasting style; scales/arpeggios; sight-reading
- Percussion: 1 short solo on each—concert snare drum, rudimental snare drum, timpani, and keyboard percussion; 3 chromatically adjacent major scales; keyboard sight-reading
- Piano: two or more works of contrasting style; may also require scales/arpeggios; sight-reading
- Voice: two contrasting, accompanied selections from the classical, musical theater, or jazz genres (one in Italian, German, or French encouraged but not required); sight-reading
