The B2BSN Scholarship will offer Associate Degree level nurses the opportunity to complete a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree at the University of North Alabama at a discounted rate.

Students will be offered the same 20% tuition scholarship for general education courses and fees taken online at UNA to meet graduation requirements.

Students receiving the B2BSN scholarship must meet all UNA and ACONHP admission and graduation requirements. The B2BSN scholarship will be in effect for a period of **two years** from student's initial admission date. Both tracks may be completed in one year, if students continuously enroll with full-time status (12-15 credit hours per semester). Participants who do <u>not</u> complete graduation requirements by the end of the two-year agreement will be charged the current rate of tuition and fees for remaining coursework.

# **B2BSN**Frequently Asked Questions

# 1. Am I eligible for the 20% tuition scholarship for the RN-BSN and/or RN-MSN nursing programs at UNA?

To be eligible for the 20% tuition scholarship you must be a newly admitted student and a graduate of a regionally accredited AL community college. Students must also meet requirements for general admission to the RN to BSN and/or RN to MSN tracks, including:

- Be a registered nurse with a current license and in good standing with the Board of Nursing.
- Be a graduate of a regionally accredited associate degree in nursing program or diploma nursing program.
- Possess a minimum of "C" or higher in all required math, science, and Area V courses.

**RN-MSN** track students must additionally meet the following requirements:

- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA after completing 12 credit hours of undergraduate nursing courses at UNA.
- Have advisor permission to register for three graduate nursing courses.

After successful completion of all requirements for a BSN, including application for graduation, the student may apply for acceptance into the MSN program and must meet all requirements as described in the Graduate Catalog.

# 2. When can I start the RN-BSN / RN-MSN program?

There are five (5) start dates in the ACONHP. Students can enroll in the program at any of the following times:

- Fall 8 week term 1 or 2
- Spring 8 week term 1 or 2
- Summer

# 3. How long will it take for me to complete a degree?

The core nursing curriculum for the RN to BSN and RN to MSN program is 30 credit hours. If attending full-time students can complete this in as little as three semesters, however, most students will also need to complete general education courses once they have transferred to UNA.

Students will be eligible to receive the 20% scholarship for six semesters or two years of continuous enrollment.

# 4. What is the cost of the program after the 20% tuition scholarship is applied?

The 20% tuition scholarship applies to all courses. Additional expenses, such as textbooks, are not included in the cost estimate and will not qualify for the 20% reduction in costs.
