

RESEARCH GRANTS FOR STUDENT AND FACULTY TEAMS

A limited number of grants up to \$1,600 are available through the Center for Student Research. The grants will be awarded to research teams consisting of (but not limited to) at least one UNA student and one UNA faculty mentor. Students must be principal investigators and/or make significant contributions in the research process. The ideas and proposals may be new ideas or on-going research, and may be a part of a capstone project, senior research project, or independent study, but this is not a requirement. The purpose of the grants is to support student research and provide assistance with research expenses, including costs associated with conducting the research, as well as travel costs associated with presenting at professional meetings and conferences.

Requirements for consideration:

- 1. Researchers must be a student/faculty team consisting of at least one student and one faculty mentor;
- 2. Team must present at UNA Scholars Week in the Spring;
- 3. Team must present the funded research at a state, regional, or national conference in their field of study or at the National Council on Undergraduate Research held at Kennesaw State University from April 10-13 http://www.cur.org/what/events/students/ncur/2019/
- 4. Team is encouraged to use the research librarians and designated presentation practice spaces in Collier Library;
- 5. Team must submit receipts for reimbursement and a short written report of results to the Center for Student Research within 30 days of travel.

Applications must include (see attached application form provided by the Center for Student Research):

- 1. Contact information for faculty mentor and student researchers.
- 2. Conference details and an abstract of 300 words (see below for abstract requirements)
- 3. Proposed budget request (with as much detail as possible). You will have to provide receipts for reimbursement.
- 4. Detailed delineation of the student member's responsibilities and the faculty mentor's responsibilities, if any.
- 5. Email the completed application to studentresearch@una.edu by October 31.

Abstracts must:

- 1. Clearly state the central research question and/or purpose of the project.
- 2. Provide brief, relevant scholarly or research context (no actual citations required) that demonstrate its attempt to make a unique contribution to the area of inquiry.
- 3. Provide a basic description of research plan or process (methods, analysis process, etc. or whatever is fitting to the researcher's discipline);
- 4. State conclusions or expected results and the context in which they will be discussed.
- 5. References are allowed within abstracts, but not required.

A committee of university faculty from multiple disciplines will evaluate the proposals and make recommendations to the Center for Student Research. Grant recipients will be notified of awards on or before November 9, 2018.
