## MEET YOUR WORKERS' COMPENSATION SPEAKERS

RYAN G. BRAKE is a shareholder with Carr Allison and practices in the firm's Florence, Alabama office, Mr. Brake has handled workers' compensation matters on behalf of self-insured employers across Alabama.
