#### **REQUIREMENTS/ SPECIFICATIONS**

The University of North Alabama is requesting bids for the supply of box trucks and vans per the specifications contained herein. This bid document will serve as a statewide bid supporting AMSTI / ASIM within Alabama providing a mechanism for any University to order, as needed, to backfill fleet inventory. The Alabama Science in Motion program is a valuable education program promoting math, science and technology for Alabama high school students. The vehicles are used to facilitate learning laboratory environments across the state which requires they be uniquely outfitted. Therefore, all participants must confirm strict adherence to the bid specifications.

It is the intent to purchase a minimum of three (3) vehicles, two (2) box trucks and one (1) van, within 60 days of the bid opening, however there may be other demands across the state during the next 12 months due to the age of the fleet across all counties. If possible, bidders should gaurantee a price for a period of 12 months to expedite the ability of multiple school participation as budgets are assessed and approved by September 30, 2019.








