- 1. All bidders are to submit bids on proposal forms furnished by the Assistant Vice President of Business Services, University of North Alabama (forms enclosed). All bid forms are to be signed in all designated spaces by an authorized officer or employee of the bidder. Telephone bids will not be accepted. Bids submitted by "fax" machine will not be accepted. All bids are to be mailed or delivered in a sealed envelope.
- 2. All bidders shall base their proposals on the exact schedule of equipment, material or service specifications herein.
- 3. Pictures, descriptions, and specifications should accompany all bids when required or desirable. Samples may be required and, if so, shall be furnished free of cost to the Owner.
- 4. Reference to manufacturers, suppliers, catalog numbers, etc., is intended to set quality standards and does not preclude bids from others as long as quality standards are met. Offers of equal items shall state the brand and number or level of quality. Alternates will not be considered unless they conform to the specifications.
- 5. All bidders are required to submit unit prices and extended prices, where applicable, for each item bid. Where the unit price and the extended total price do not agree, the unit price shall prevail.
- 6. The Owner reserves the right to accept any or all items on any bidder's proposal at the unit price submitted. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities.
- 7. All prices submitted on the proposal are to be delivered prices to the University of North Alabama and shall not include any state or local sales tax.

- **A. GENERAL:** It is the intent of the University to consider a new vendor hosted personnel performance evaluation system capable of meeting the needs of a higher education employer with approximately 500 staff employees. An efficient, all inclusive, paperless, completely configurable system is desired. Currently this annual activity is managed with digital forms that must be printed, signed and forwarded.
- **B.** QUALIFIED BIDDERS: Only qualified responsive bids will be considered. Qualified Bidders must provide complete RFP package and meet all necessary functional requirements within the system proposed. Evaluations will be based on complete submission requirements, ease of use, overall features and function, implementation timeline necessary, sustainability and total cost of ownership over time. The University will determine in its sole discretion the most efficient, cost effective solution acceptable for the needed scope of use.
- **C.** <u>RIGHT TO REJECT:</u> The University of North Alabama reserves the right to reject any, or all, proposals received in response to this RFP. A contract for the accepted proposal will be based upon the qualification factors described herein.

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MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS

The following list of specifications is meant to clarify the requirement and to outline the intent and expectation of use. The university will not rely upon assumptions. As a minimum the system should:

- Provide mechanisms that ensure and promote data accuracy, quality and rapid data entry;
- Enable all authorized personnel to access evaluation information at any time via a web-based portal regardless of browser;
- Allow the System Administrator(s) to assign views and data access to relevant employee data and job information for specific roles and users;
- Allow for multiple authorized users to access the same data at the same time;
- Provide an audit trail of evaluation process activity;
- Workflow management including e-signatures, timelines, alerts regarding missing or incomplete evaluations;
- Have the ability to create and track goals, development plans, performance plans, and journal entries;
- The system should have the ability to export evaluation reports and additional data to document imaging system for storage in employee personnel files. Exported data out of the hosted solution should provide for a secure encrypted transport when downloading through the internet;
- The system should have a multi-rater feature;
- Different evaluation templates, evaluation scales, processes, and workflows depending on job position and/or department;
- Support several evaluation review cycles;
- Ability to customize graphic interface to comply with UNA branding standards;
- Ability to make fields mandatory;
- Compatible with UNA's Active Directory, single sign-on;
- Store previous years' evaluation for review;
- Security such that employees and supervisors can view only their specified data;
- Ability to allow users to attach files and documents in a variety of formats
