- 1. All bidders are to submit bids on proposal forms furnished by the Assistant Vice President of Business Services, University of North Alabama (forms enclosed). All bid forms are to be signed in all designated spaces by an authorized officer or employee of the bidder. Telephone bids will not be accepted. Bids submitted by "fax" machine will not be accepted. All bids are to be mailed or delivered in a sealed envelope.
- 2. All bidders shall base their proposals on the exact schedule of equipment, material or service specifications herein.
- 3. Pictures, descriptions, and specifications should accompany all bids when required or desirable. Samples may be required and, if so, shall be furnished free of cost to the Owner.
- 4. Reference to manufacturers, suppliers, catalog numbers, etc., is intended to set quality standards and does not preclude bids from others as long as quality standards are met. Offers of equal items shall state the brand and number or level of quality. Alternates will not be considered unless they conform to the specifications.
- 5. All bidders are required to submit unit prices and extended prices, where applicable, for each item bid. Where the unit price and the extended total price do not agree, the unit price shall prevail.
- 6. The Owner reserves the right to accept any or all items on any bidder's proposal at the unit price submitted. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities.

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

The University is seeking proposals for the installation of network infrastructure to all fiber connectivity the breadth of campus. Contractor minimal scope of requirements to install the fiber include aerial lashing, trenching, core / bore drilling under city streets and utilities, placing required conduit and access handholes. Only qualified contactors will be considered. The University reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to waive technical errors if, in the owner's judgment, the best interests of the owner will thereby be promoted. An award may be made for one, or none of these projects dependent upon bid results and budget approval.

To be considered Qualified Contractor must:

- be licensed for this type of work within Lauderdale County, Alabama;
- ➤ have BICSI certified staff employed;
- secure permits for any required easements / access to city locations;
- > attend one of the site reviews to understand path expectation;
- provide a firm fixed price for each installation segment as requested;
- provide a performance bond and evidence of insurance;
- submit a complete Bid Document on time.

The referenced map provides a recommended path for installation. Actual path will be agreed upon by UNA and winning bidder. References to handholes, poles, lots, and buildings are noted on the associated map.

All handholes/Quazite boxes should be 24x36x24 in size and must include a cover and a gravel base (gravel to be provided by winning bidder).

Fiber referenced below will be provided by UNA and is 48 (2x24) strand. Winning bidder must provide appropriate service loops during installation of fiber.

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Winning bidder must provide mule-tape inside all conduit locations to facilitate UNA installing fiber infrastructure at a later date.

Winning bidder must contact location services for locating utilities. UNA is responsible for location of existing fiber infrastructure located on UNA property.

- Furnish and install handhole (24x36x24 Quazite box with cover) near pole in Cedar street parking lot M (labeled HH1).
- Excavate to find existing conduit and extend to new handhole.
- Bore (1) 4" pipe from new handhole (labeled HH1) under Cedar street to west side of Cedar street.
- Install new Quazite box on west side of Cedar street (labeled HH2).
- Bore (1) 4" pipe from handhole (labeled HH2) on west side of Cedar Street uphill to NE side of Larimore Street.
- Install new Quazite Box on NE side of Cypress Street (labeled HH3).
- Bore (1) 4" pipe from NE side of Cypress Street, under Cypress Street to West side of street.
- Install new Quazite box on W side of Cypress Street (labeled HH4).
