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# INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- 1. All bidders are to submit bids on proposal forms furnished by the Associate Vice President of Business and Financial Affairs, University of North Alabama (forms enclosed). All bid forms are to be signed in all designated spaces by an authorized officer or employee of the bidder. Telephone bids will not be accepted. Bids submitted by "fax" machine will not be accepted. All bids are to be mailed or delivered in a sealed envelope.
- 2. All bidders shall base their proposals on the full scope of service specifications herein.
- The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities. Any discrepancies observed upon opening bids shall be publicly noted at that time.
- 4. All prices submitted on the proposal are to be all inclusive for work performed and shall not include any state or local sales tax. Submission of a completed DCM Form C-3A: Accounting of Sales Tax is required.
- 5. Bidders should sign & return all pages of the complete bid to imply complete understanding and compliance with all bid requirements.
- 6. Should a bidder find discrepancies in, or omissions from the bid documents or should such bidder be in doubt as to their meaning, the bidder should at once notify the Owner who will send written instructions to all potential bidders.
- 7. Bids received after the bid opening date and time, or any authorized postponement thereof, will not be considered.
- 8. A bid security must be furnished with all bids in excess of \$50,000.00. The bid security shall be in the form of a bid bond (executed by a surety company duly authorized and qualified to make such bonds in Alabama) or a cashier's check (drawn on an Alabama bank) payable to the Owner. The amount of the bid security must be no less than 5% of the contractor's bid, not to exceed \$10,000.00. If a bid bond is furnished in lieu of a cashier's check, DCM Form C-4, Form of Bid Bond, is to be used.
- 9. Title 34, Chapter 8, <u>Code of Alabama, 1975</u>, required licensing for general contracting when the cost of work exceeds an amount established by the State Licensing Board for General Contractors. All bidders must show evidence of this license before bidding.

  Therefore, the outside of the sealed bid must bear the bidder's name and state license number for general contracting.
- 10. Upon bid award, Contractor will provide Certificate of Insurance naming the University of North Alabama as additionally insured for the duration of the project.
- 11. EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY/U.S. FAIR LABOR STANDARDS ACT: By signing this proposal, bidder certifies that bidder is in compliance with the nondiscrimination clause contained in Section 202, Executive Order 11246, as amended by Executive Order 11375, relative to Equal Employment Opportunity for all persons without regard to race, color, religion, sex, or national origin, and the rules and regulations prescribed by the Secretary of Labor, Veteran's Act 38USC4212, Section 503 Rehabilitation act of 1973 Title I of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 42USC12101, and that any and all goods were produced in compliance with all applicable requirements of Sections 6, 7, and 12 of the Fair Labor Standards Act, as amended, and of regulations and orders of the United States Department of Labor issued under Section 14 thereof.

#### **Overview:**

The University of North Alabama is seeking licensed contractors to make exterior hardscape improvements to Lafayette Hall. The building is located at 151 Shelby Way, Florence, AL 35630. Time is of the essence; all work will be coordinated with the University Facilities Department with the expectation to commitment to timeline.

**Scope of Work:** Per Lafayette Hall Perimeter Hardscape construction documents dated May 12, 2022 prepared by Cr3ate Architects, Inc. (Project No. 22218). The work generally includes:

- Removal and replacement of front (east) sidewalk and entry stair
- Provide proper drainage with new sidewalk and entry approach meeting ADA regulations
- Provide equipment and staging necessary to complete
- Repair any peripheral areas impacted during construction back to "before construction" condition
