

ANDERSON BIKE PROGRAM PROTOCOLS

- E-bikes are not allowed inside UNA facilities.
- You are responsible for damages caused by and to the e-bike.
- It is important to ALWAYS lock your e-bike.
- The E-bike charger should be taken inside if locking the e-bike outside overnight.
- It is recommended that you not allow others to ride the e-bike
- The weight limit of the bike is 300lbs. The load should never exceed this amount (carrying cargo or another passenger). Structural and mechanical failure will occur if over this weight limit.
- If you do not return your e-bike and accessories when requested there may be a fee.
- If you believe that the e-bike needs maintenance and is not safe, do not ride it and contact Glenda Richey gkrichey@una.edu
- Equipment replacement and/or repair price for damage or theft:
 - o E-Bike -\$1,200.00
 - Battery- \$551.50
 - Charger- \$59.00
 - o Helmet- \$79.00
 - o Lock- \$18.00
 - o Key-\$15.00

Failure to comply with the protocols listed above will result in repossession of the E-bike, helmet, charger, lock, and key.
