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University of North Alabama Students and Faculty at a Glance:

Student Profile - Fall 2002

- * **Number of Students** 5,416 total students of which 4,826 (89%) are undergraduate students and 590 (11%) are graduate students.
- * **Status of Students** 4,158 (77%) are full-time students and 1,258 (23%) are part-time students
- * **Gender of Students** 3,222 (59%) are female and 2,194 (41%) are male
- * **Age of Students** 72% of all students are less than 25 years of age, 26% of all students are 25 to 49 years of age, and 2% of the students are 50 years and older.
- * **Ethnicity of Students** 77% are white, 11% are black, 2% are American Indian/Alaskan Native, 5% did not report ethnic group, 3% are International, and 2% are from other ethnic groups
- * **Residency of Students** 77% are residents of Alabama, 10% are residents of Tennessee, 5% are residents of Mississippi, 4% are from 32 other states, and 4% from 36 foreign countries
- * **Housing of Students** 20% of undergraduate students live in student housing on campus

Faculty Profile - Fall 2002

- * **Number of Faculty** 296 instructional faculty of which 198 (67%) are full-time and 98 (33%) are part-time
- * **Rank of Full-Time Faculty** 28% are professors, 23% are associate professors, 38% are assistant professors, and 11% are instructors
- * **Gender of Full-Time Faculty** 59% are male and 41% are female
- * **Ethnicity of Full-Time Faculty** 88% are white, 6% are black, and 6% are from other ethnic groups
- * **Credentials of Full-Time Faculty** 71% hold a doctoral degree and 75% are considered terminally prepared in their discipline.
- * **Tenure Status of Full-Time Faculty** 70% are tenured, 19% are non-tenured on tenure track, and 11% are on non-tenure track

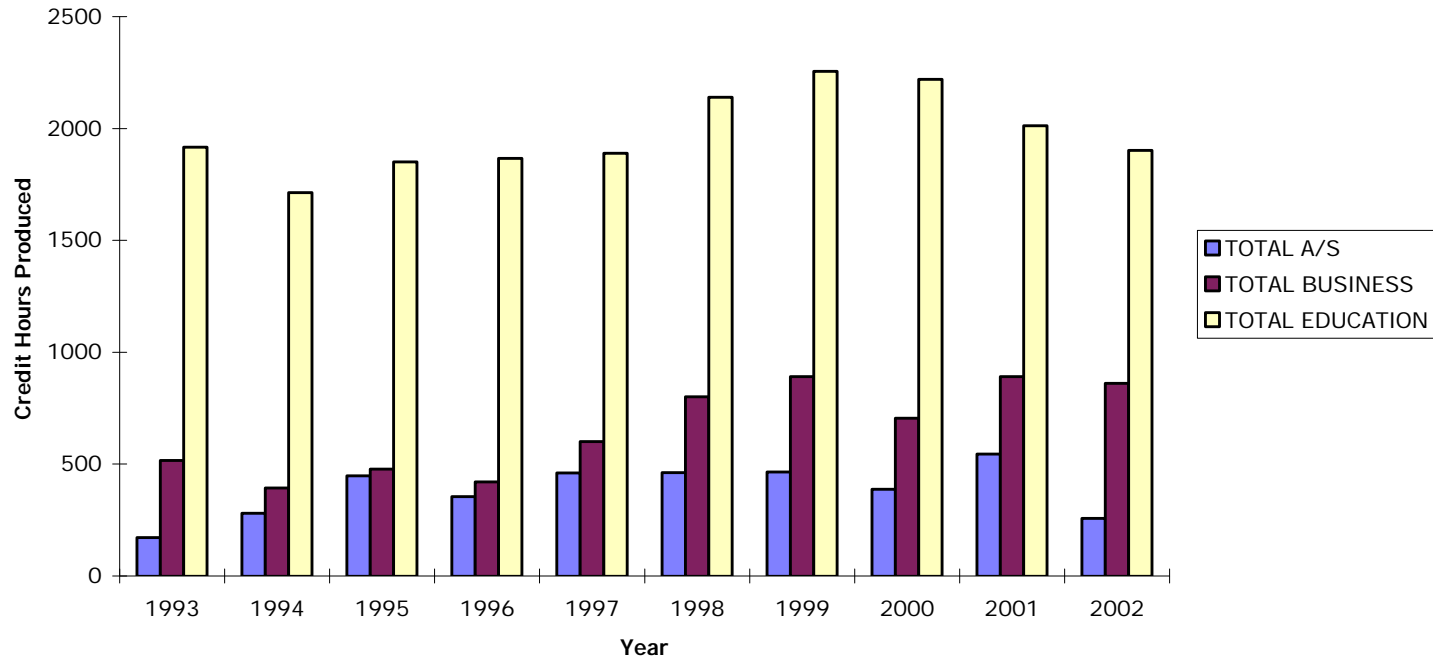

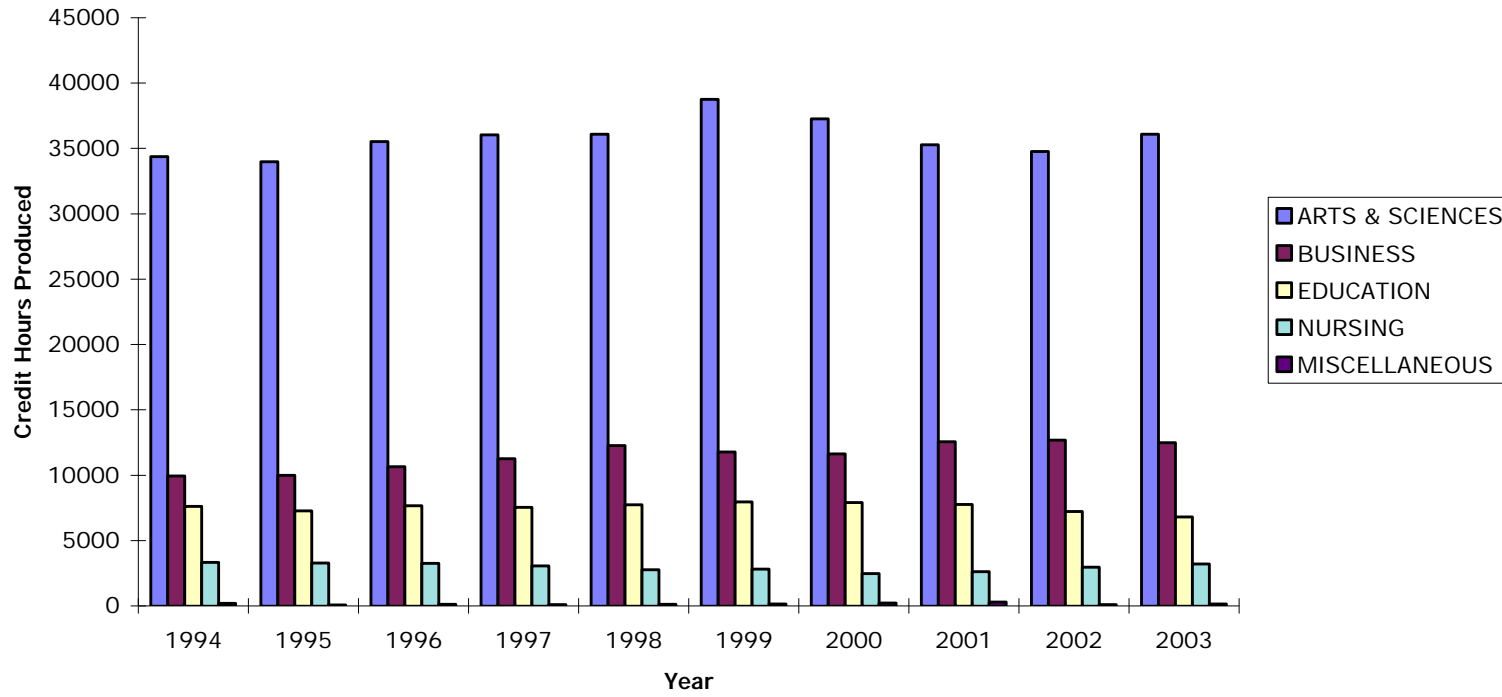

Combined Undergraduate and Graduate Credit Hour Production Spring 1994 - Spring 2003

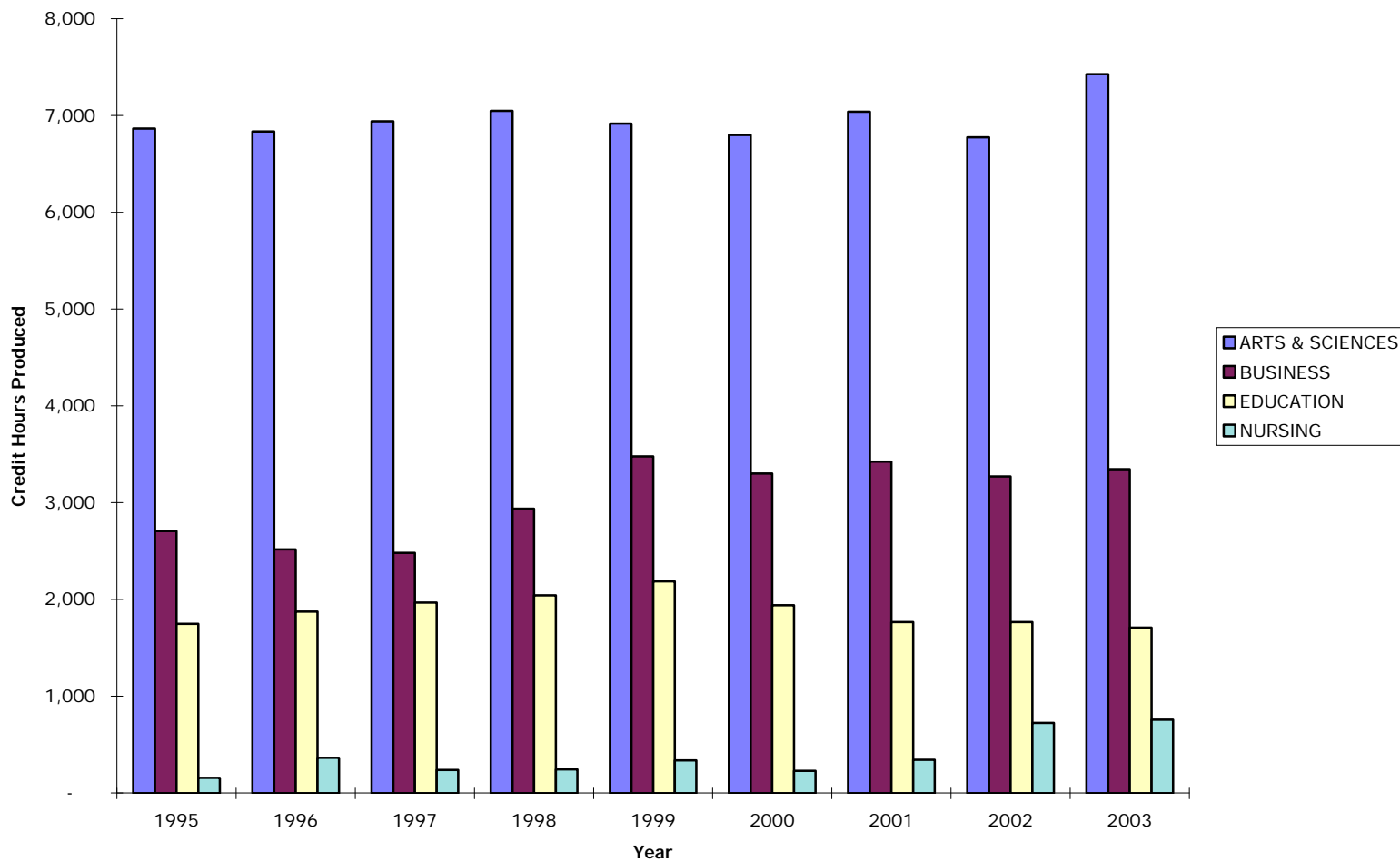

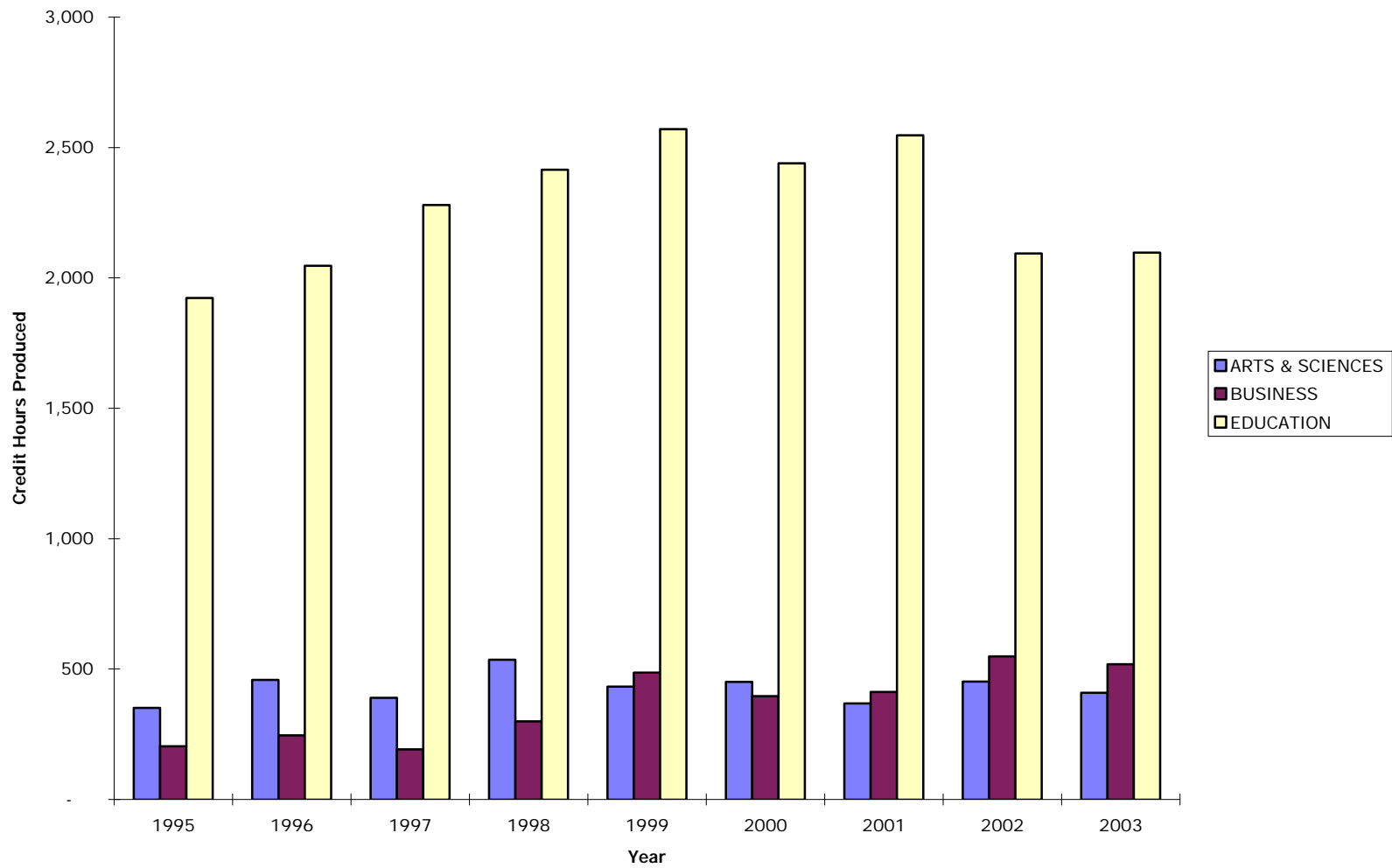

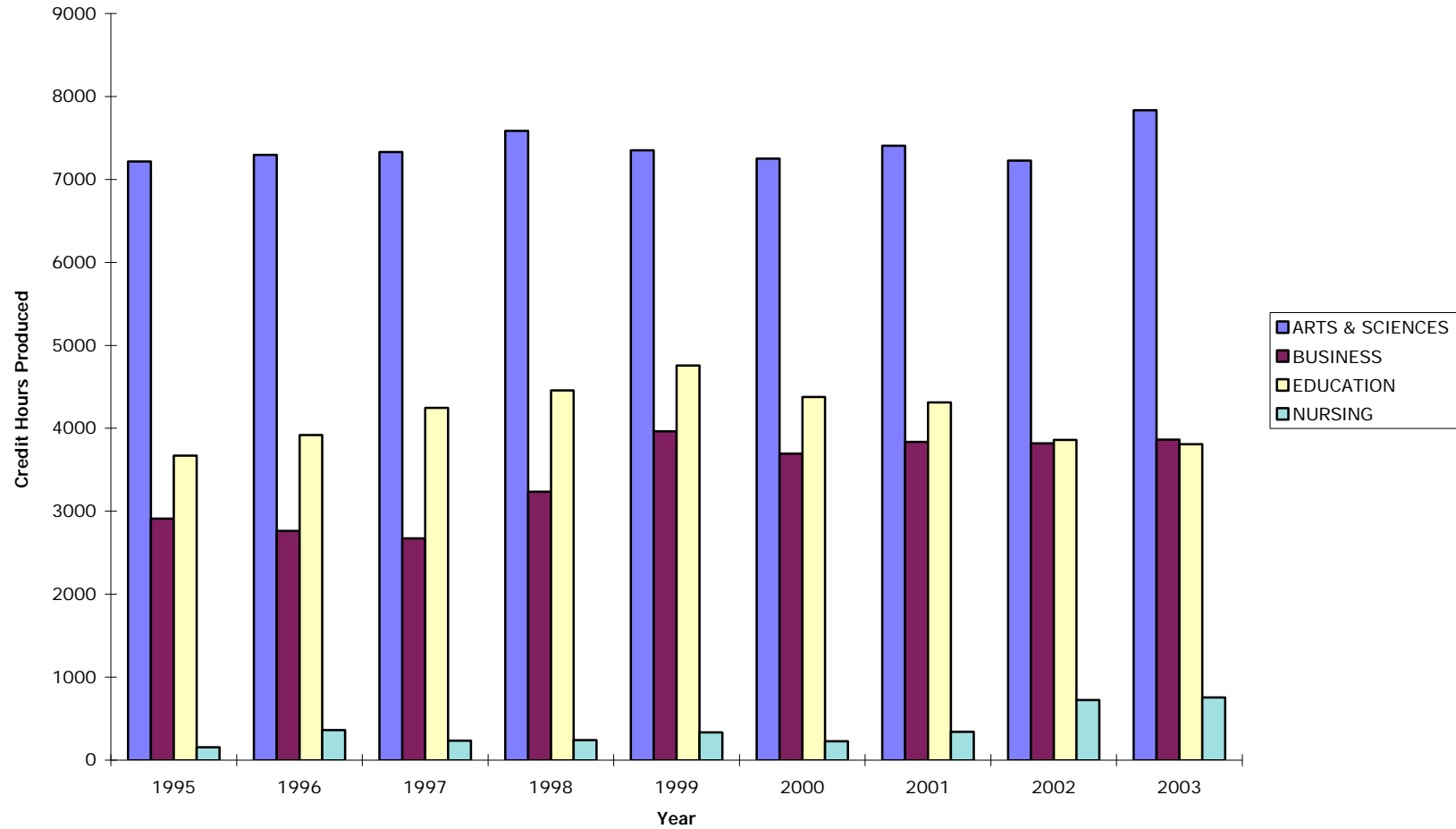
Undergraduate Credit Hour Production Summer 1995 - Summer 2003

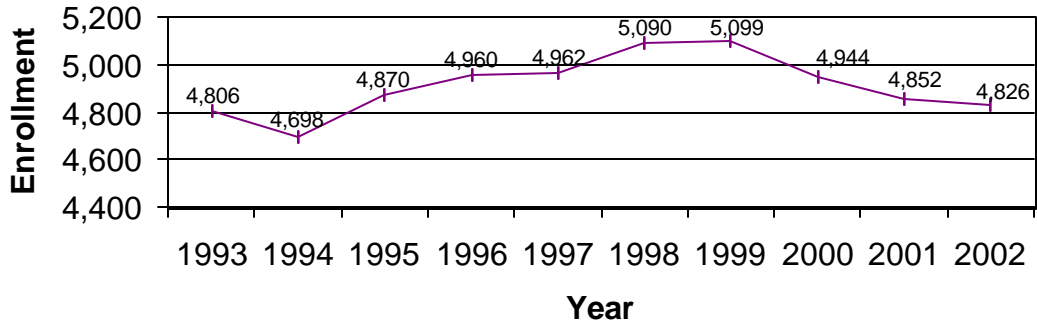

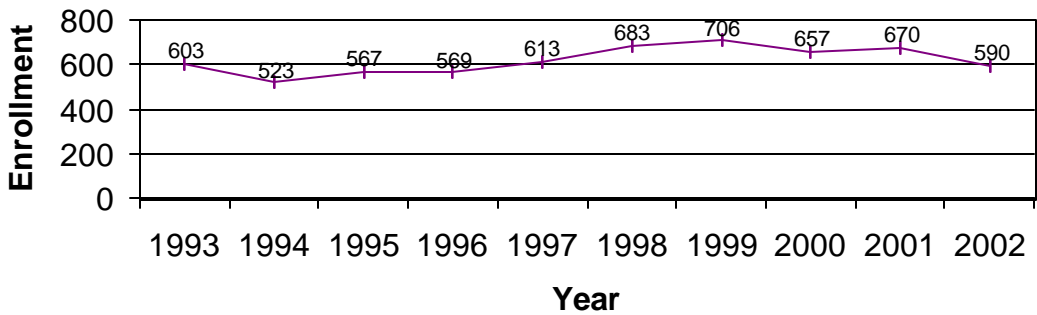

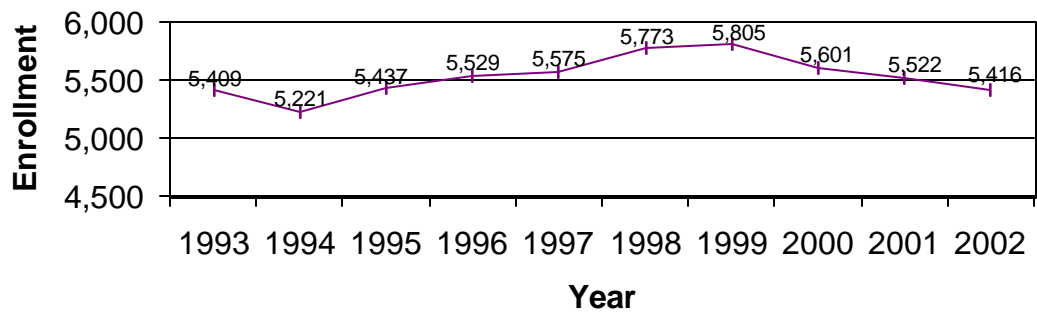
Undergraduate Enrollment Trends Fall 1993 - Fall 2002

Total Enrollment Trends Fall 1993 - Fall 2002

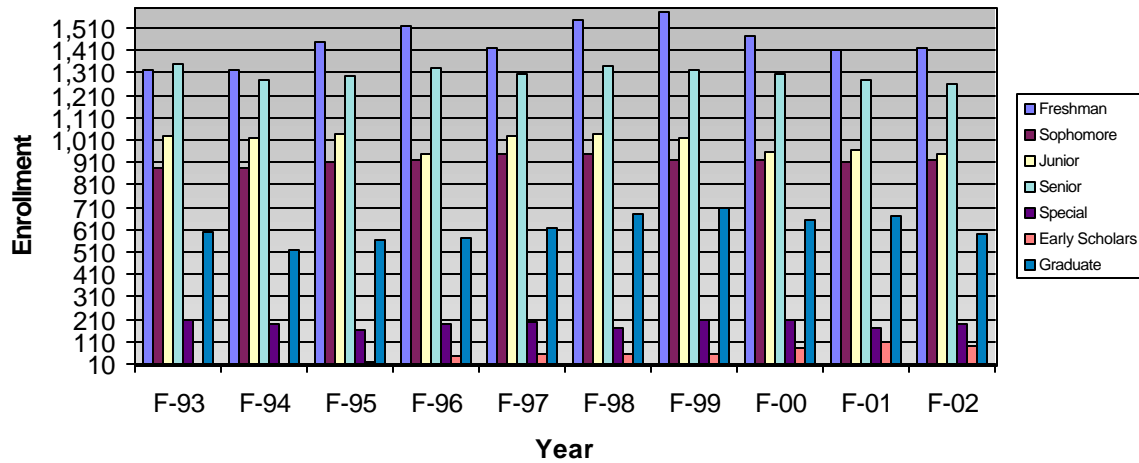

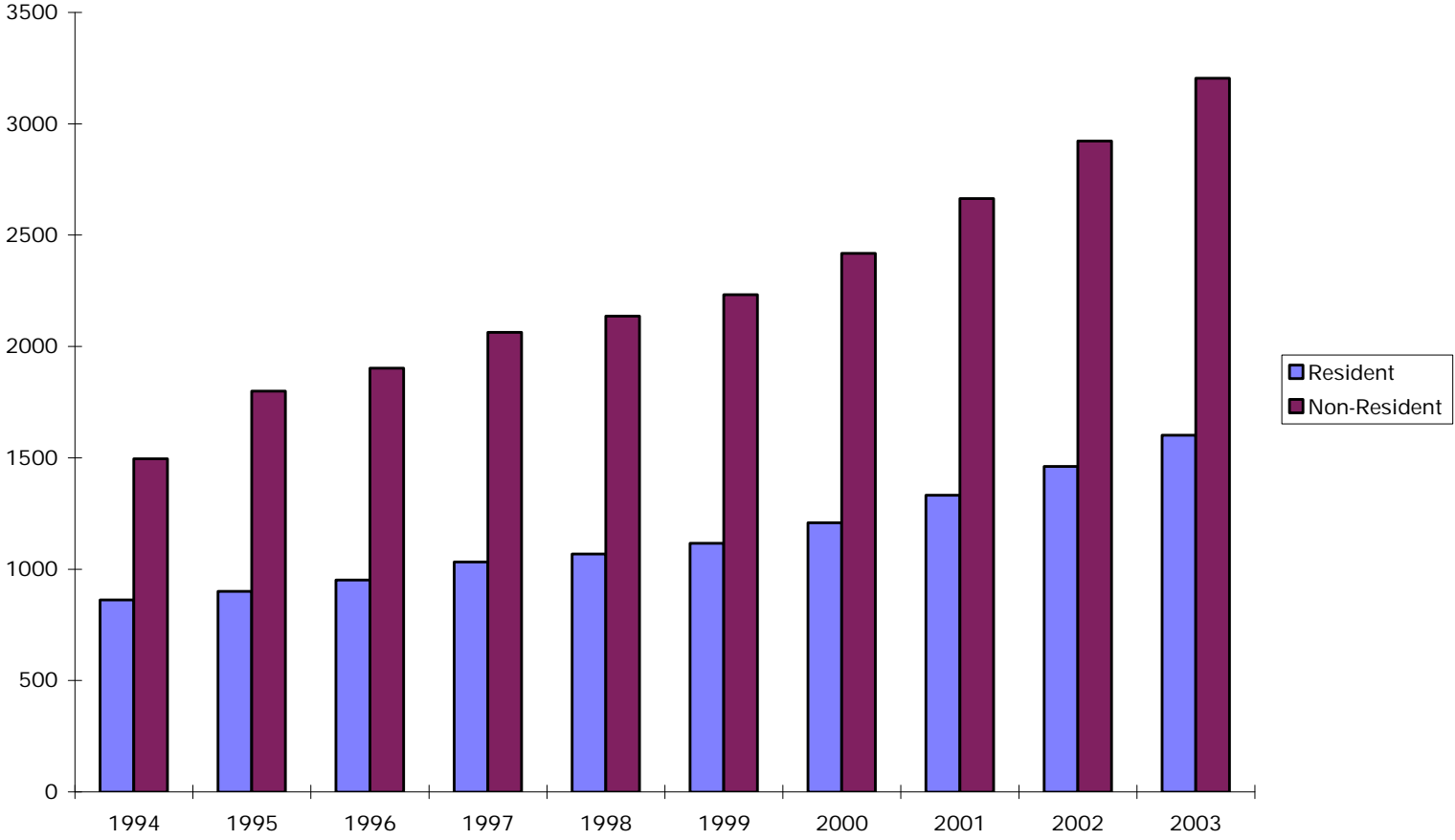

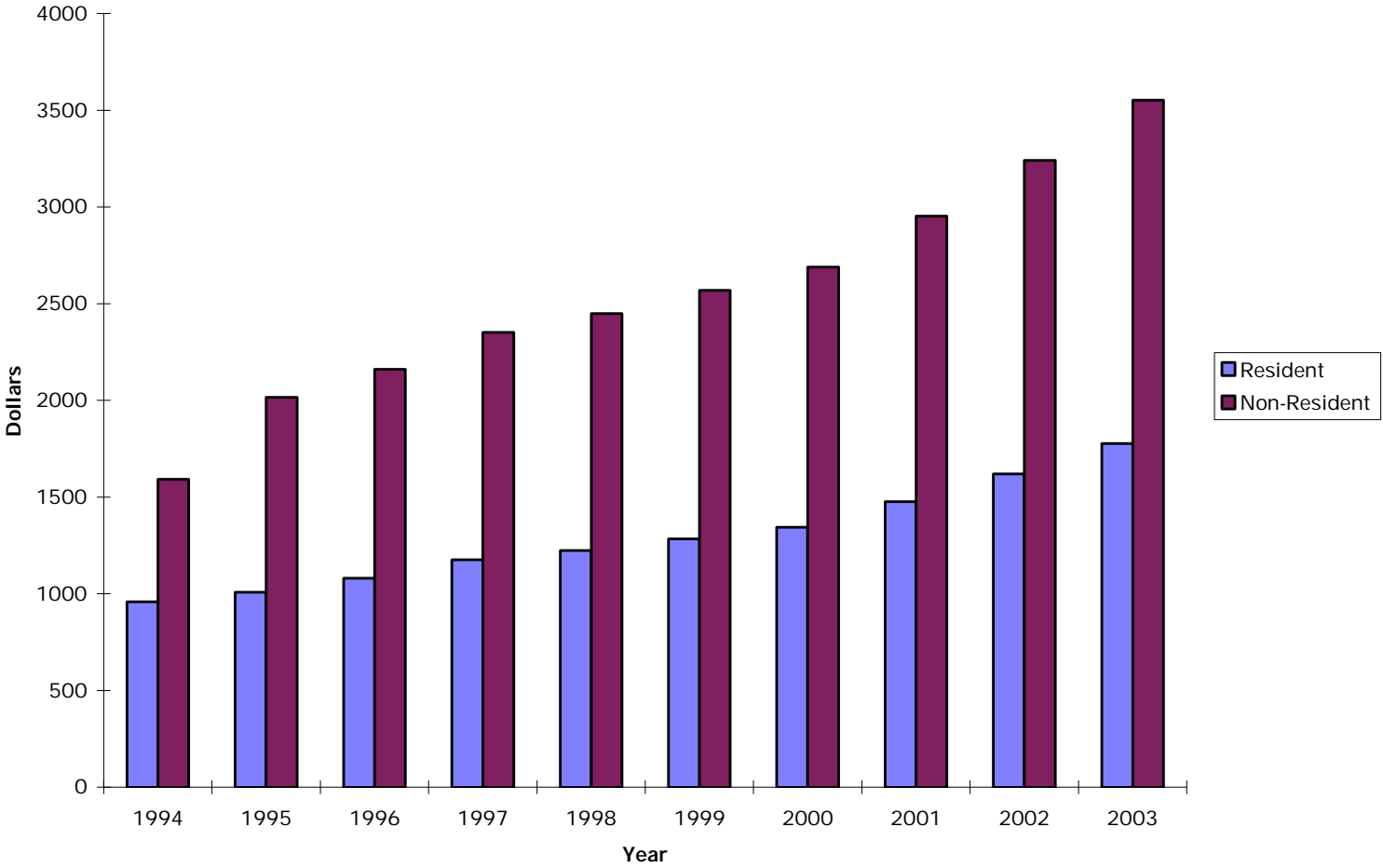
