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University of North Alabama Students and Faculty at a Glance:

Student Profile - Fall 2003

- * **Number of Students** 5,630 total students of which 4,995 (89%) are undergraduate students and 635 (11%) are graduate students.
- * **Status of Students** 4,223 (75%) are full-time students and 1,407 (25%) are part-time students
- * **Gender of Students** 3,336 (59%) are female and 2,294 (41%) are male
- * **Age of Students** 72% of all students are less than 25 years of age, 26% of all students are 25 to 49 years of age, and 2% of the students are 50 years and older.
- * **Ethnicity of Students** 77% are white, 9% are black, 2% are American Indian/Alaskan Native, 7% did not report ethnic group, 4% are International, and 1% are from other ethnic groups
- * **Residency of Students** 76% are residents of Alabama, 10% are residents of Tennessee, 5% are residents of Mississippi, 5% are from 36 other states, and 4% from 34 foreign countries
- * **Housing of Students** 19% of undergraduate students live in student housing

Faculty Profile - Fall 2003

- * **Number of Faculty** 289 instructional faculty of which 199 (69%) are full-time and 90 (31%) are part-time
- * **Rank of Full-Time Faculty** 27% are professors, 27% are associate professors, 36% are assistant professors, and 10% are instructors
- * **Gender of Full-Time Faculty** 59% are male and 41% are female
- * **Ethnicity of Full-Time Faculty** 88% are white, 6% are black, and 6% are from other ethnic groups
- * **Credentials of Full-Time Faculty** 68% hold a doctoral degree and 73% are considered terminally prepared in their discipline.
- * **Tenure Status of Full-Time Faculty** 69% are tenured, 20% are non-tenured on tenure track, and 11% are on non-tenure track

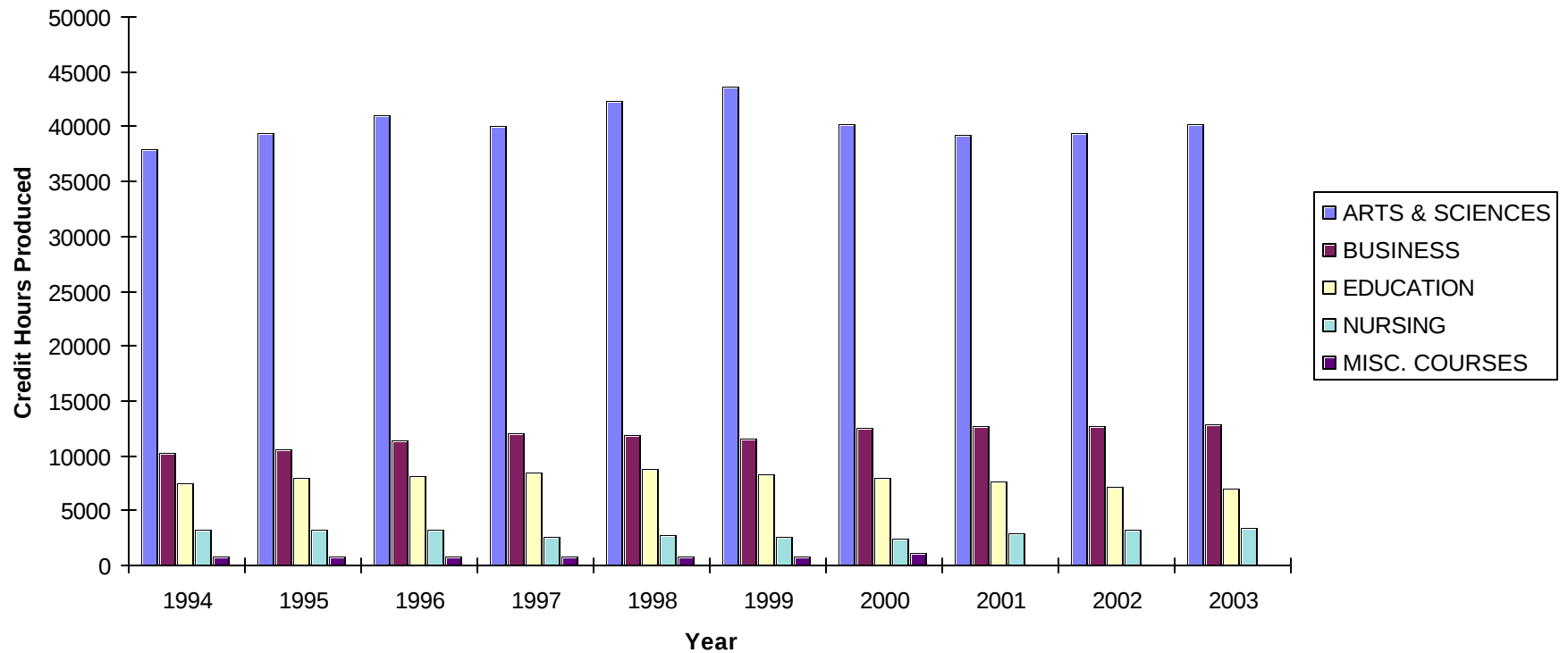

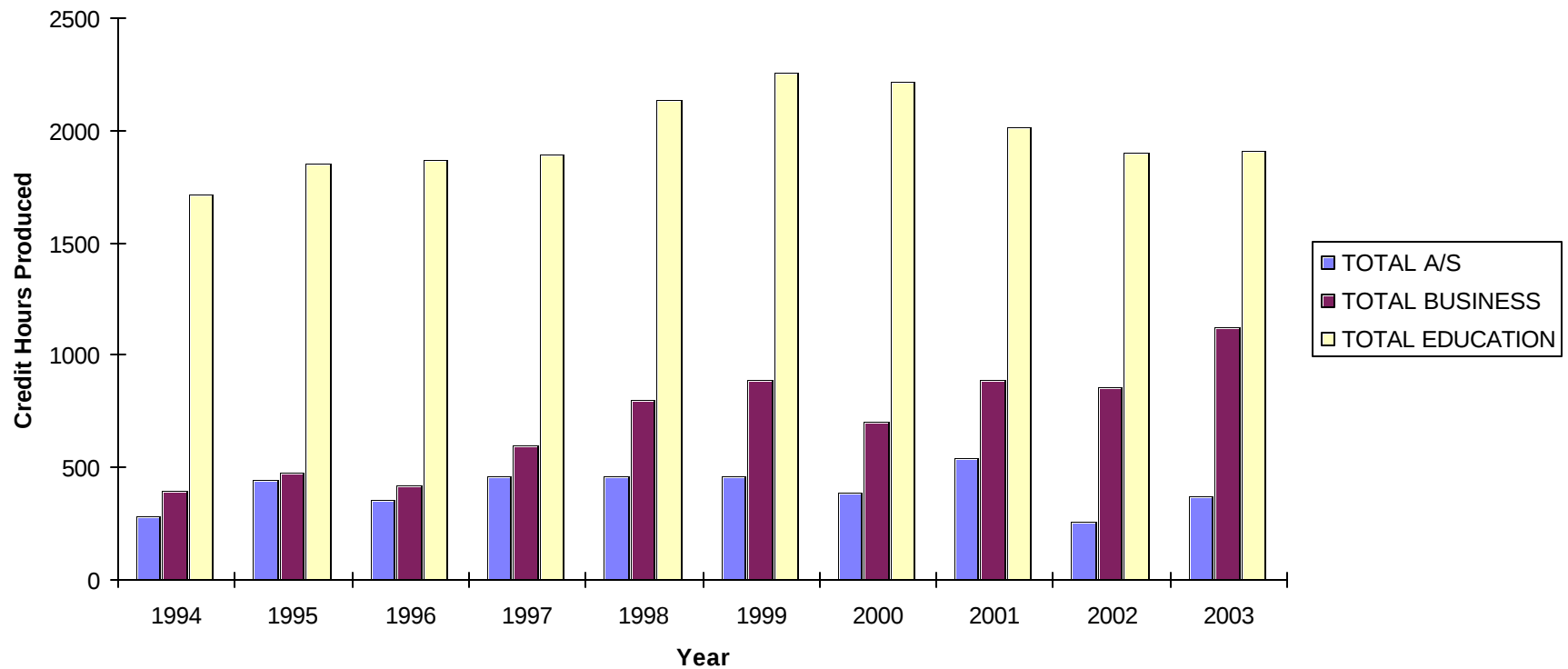

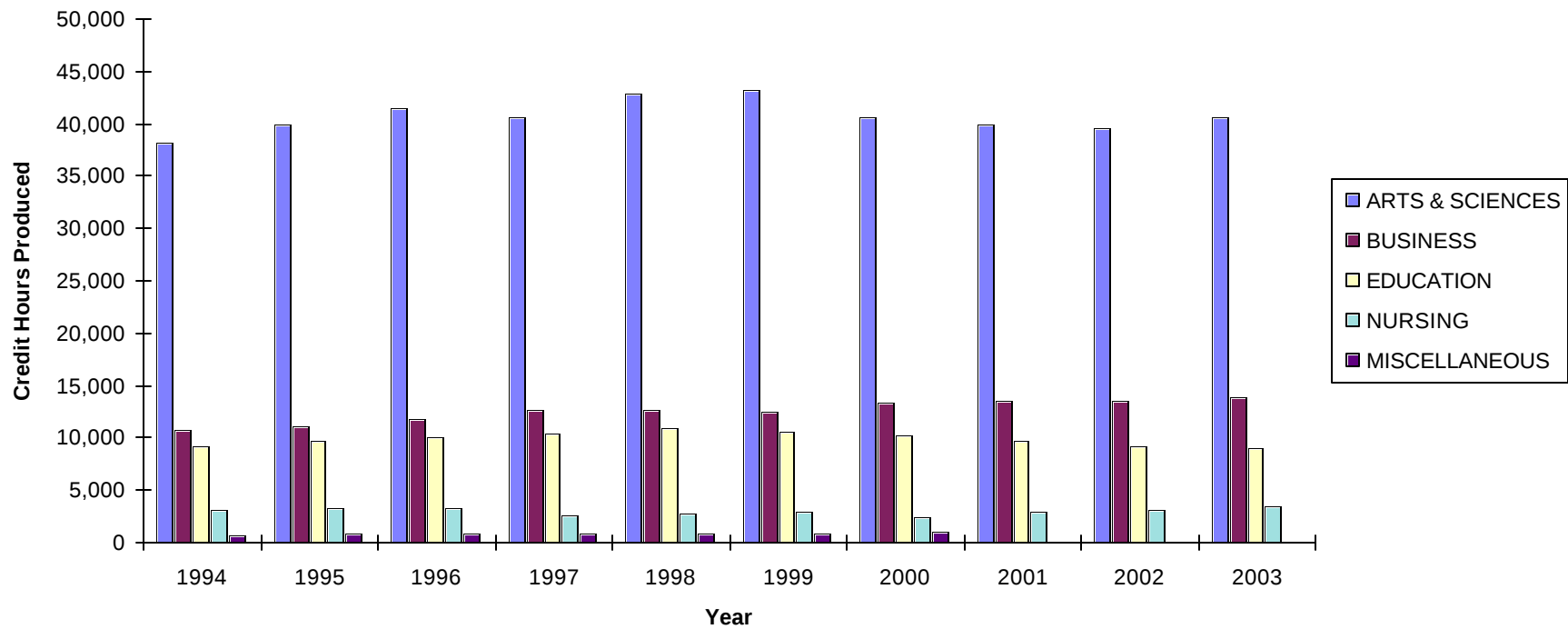
Undergraduate Credit Hour Production Fall 1994 - Fall 2003

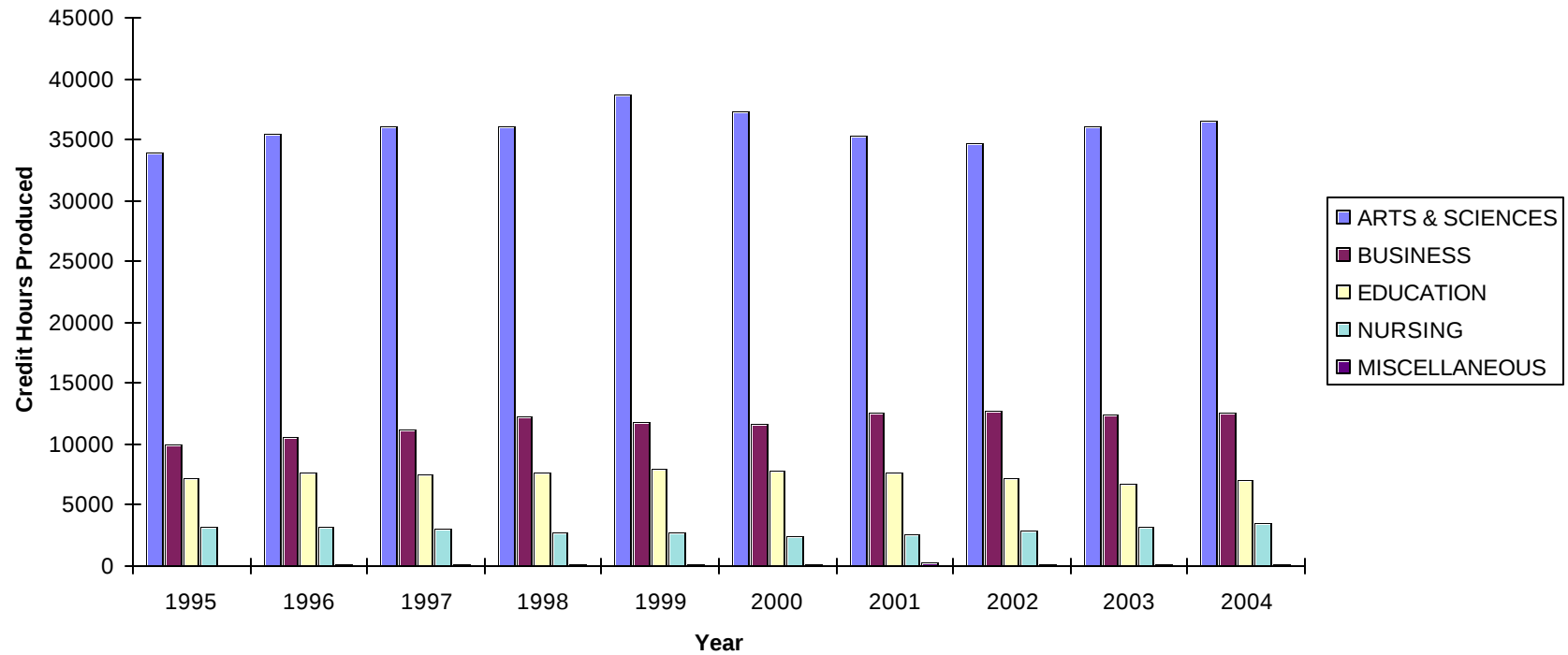

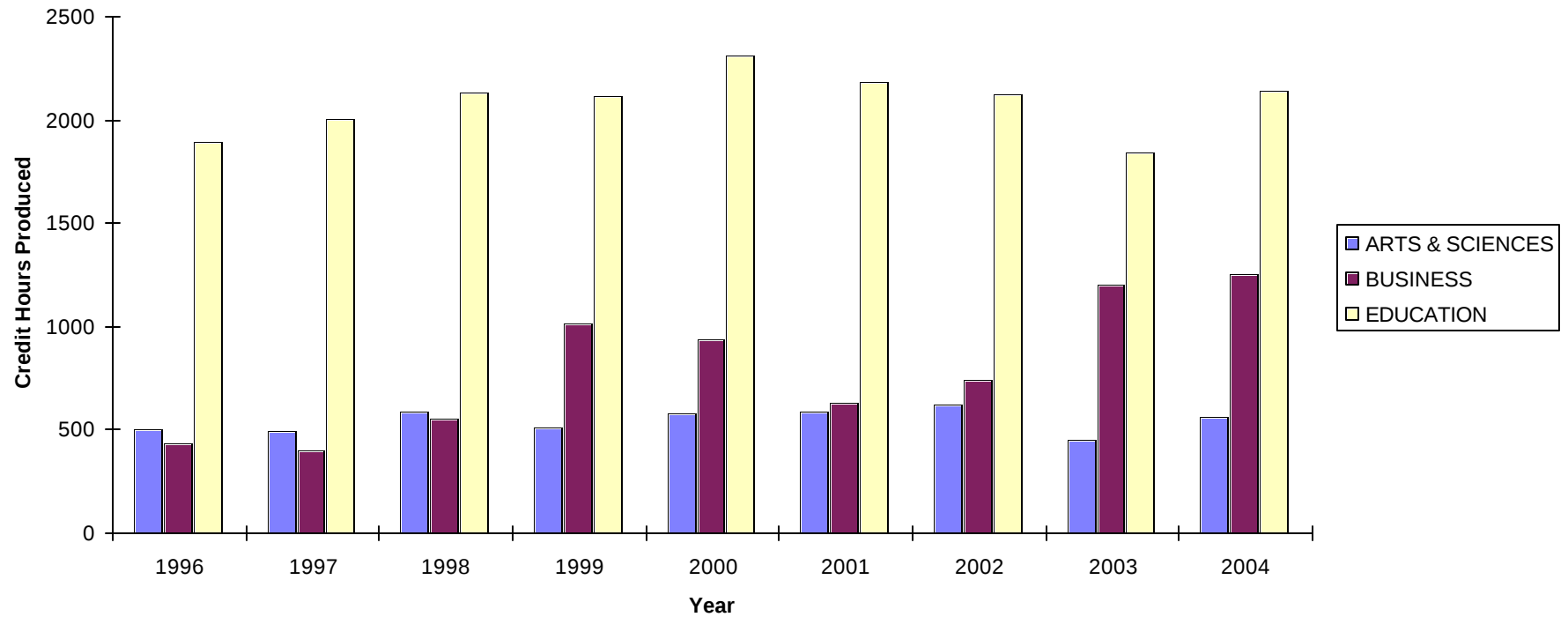

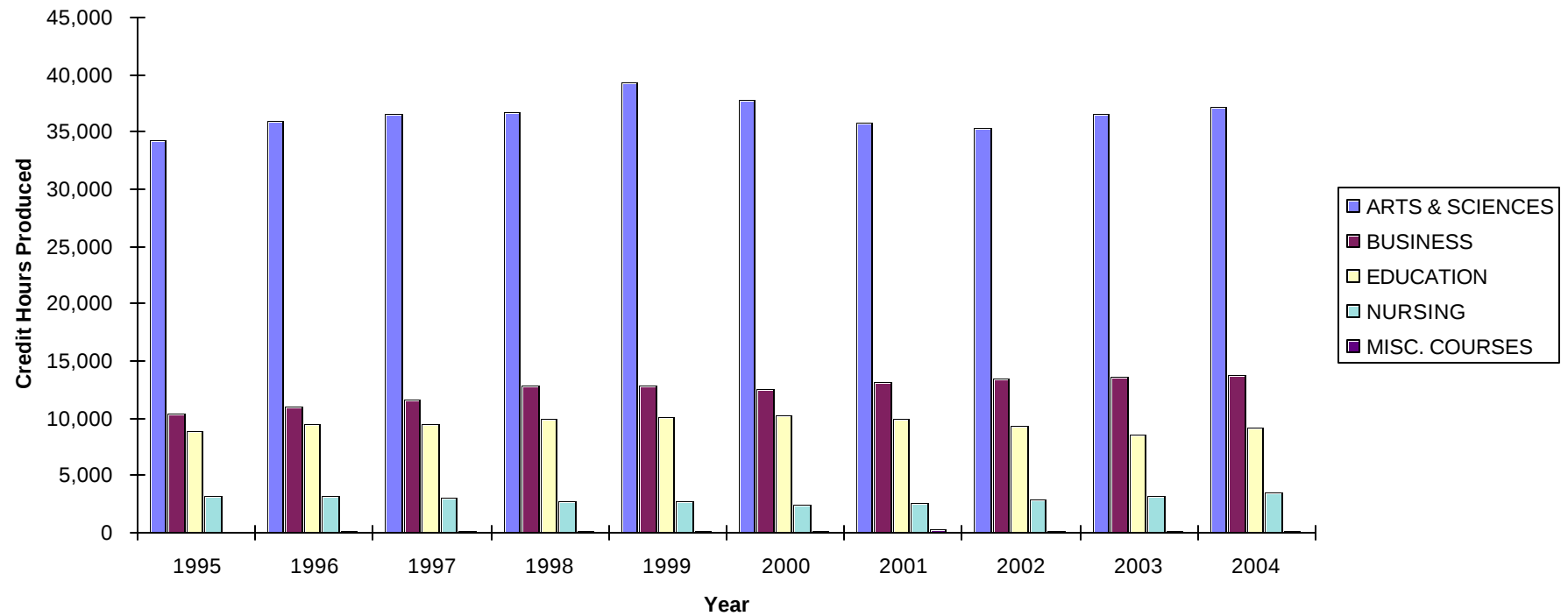

Combined Undergraduate and Graduate Credit Hour Production Spring 1995 - Spring 2004

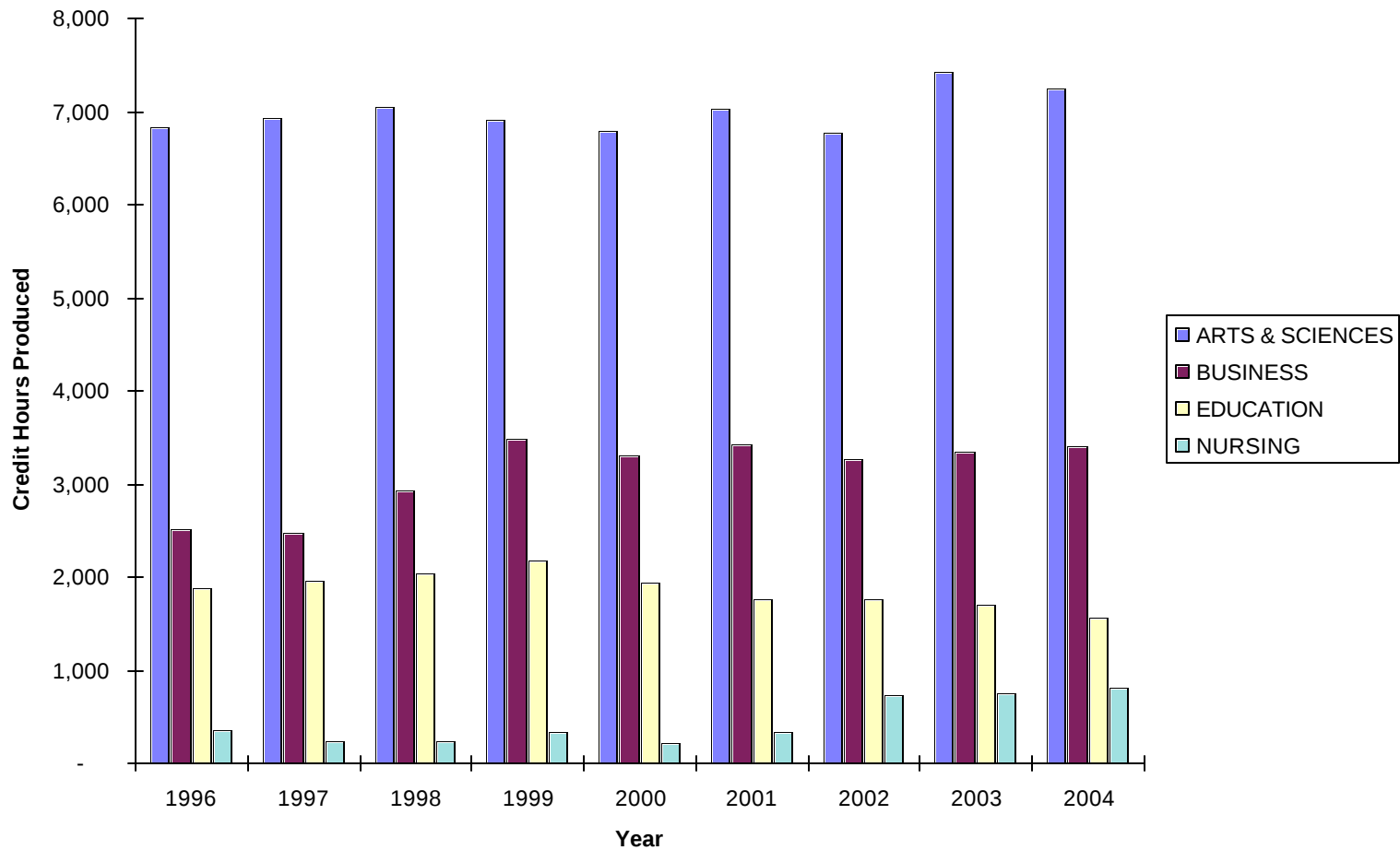

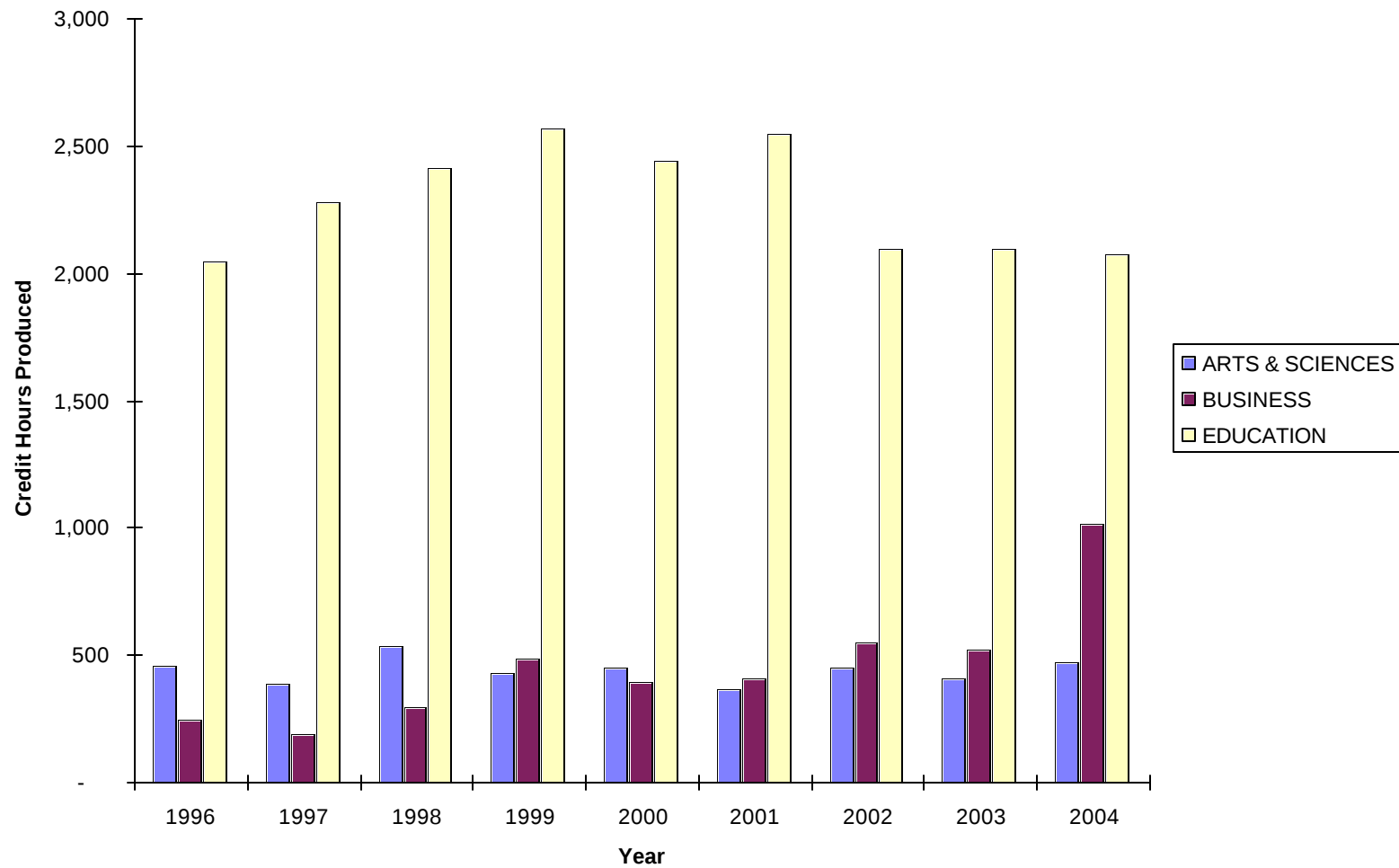

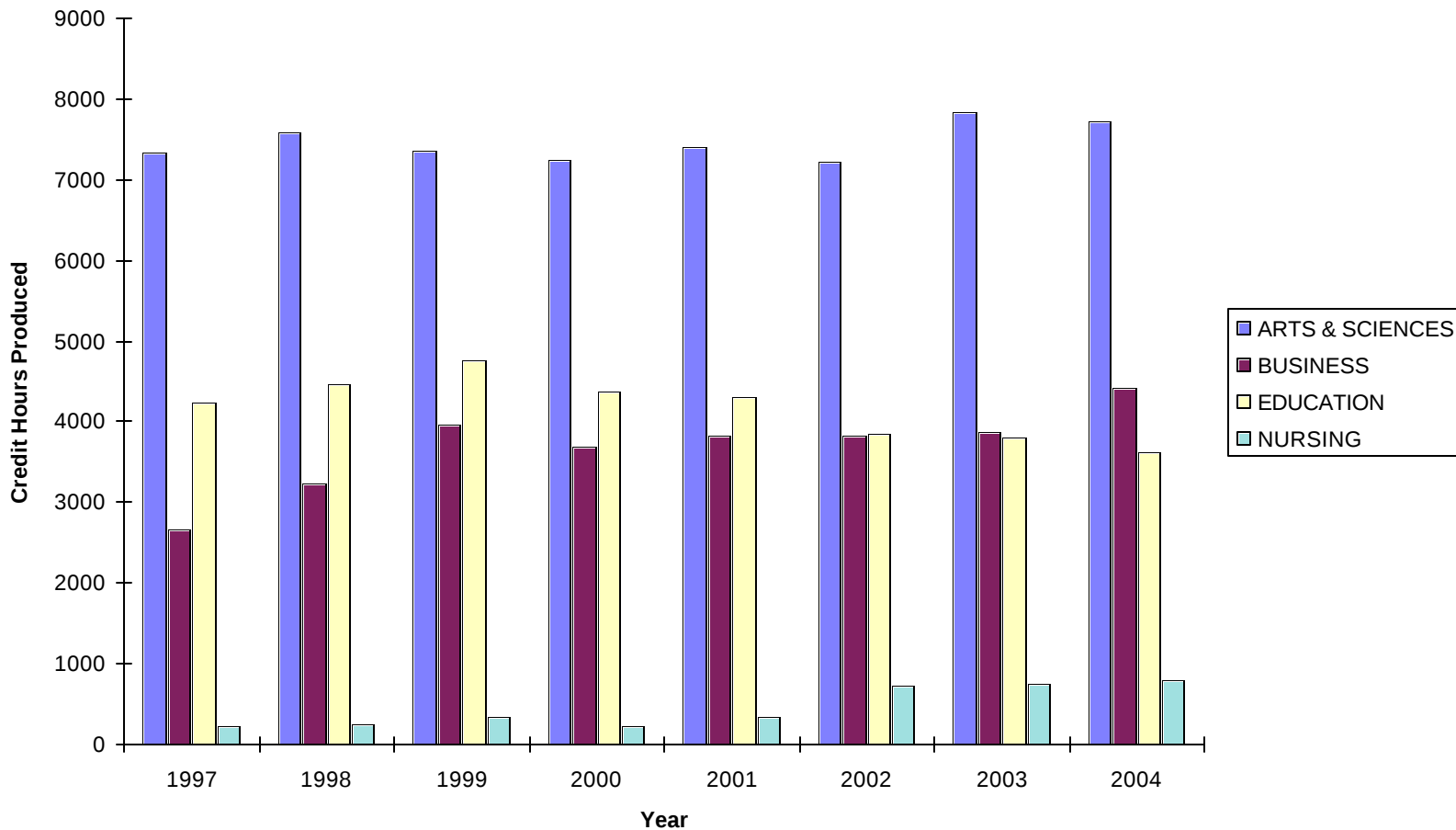
Undergraduate Credit Hour Production Summer 1996 - Summer 2004



Graduate Credit Hour Production Summer 1996 - Summer 2004

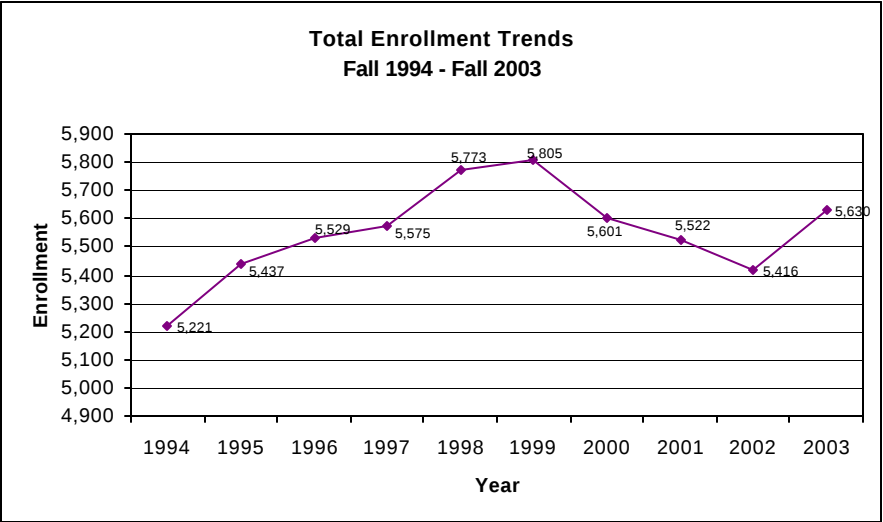
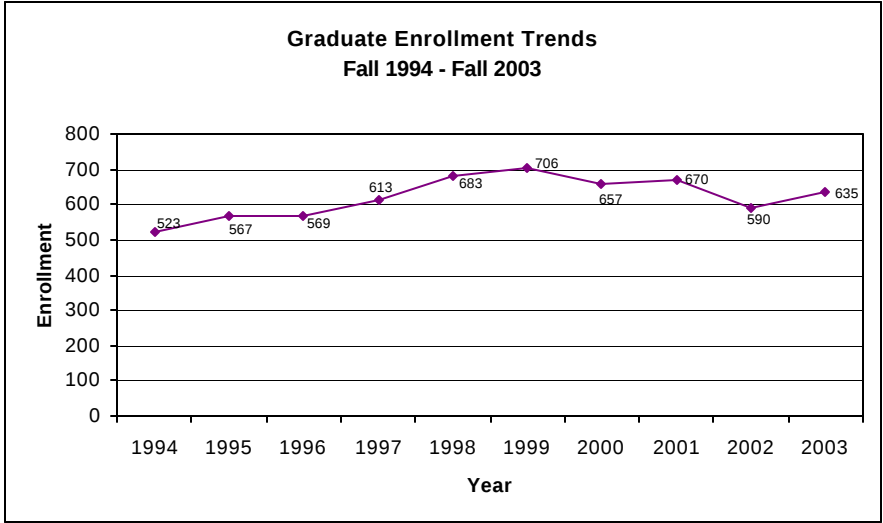
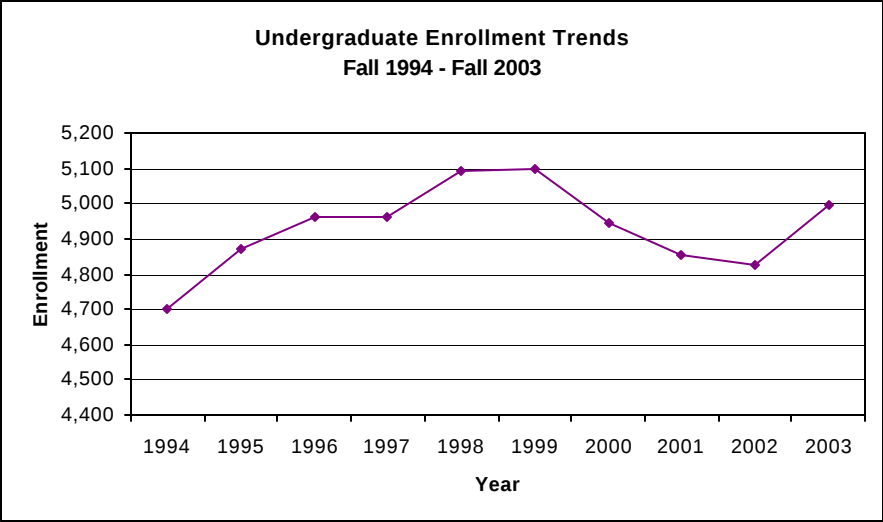


Summer Credit Hour Production - Total University

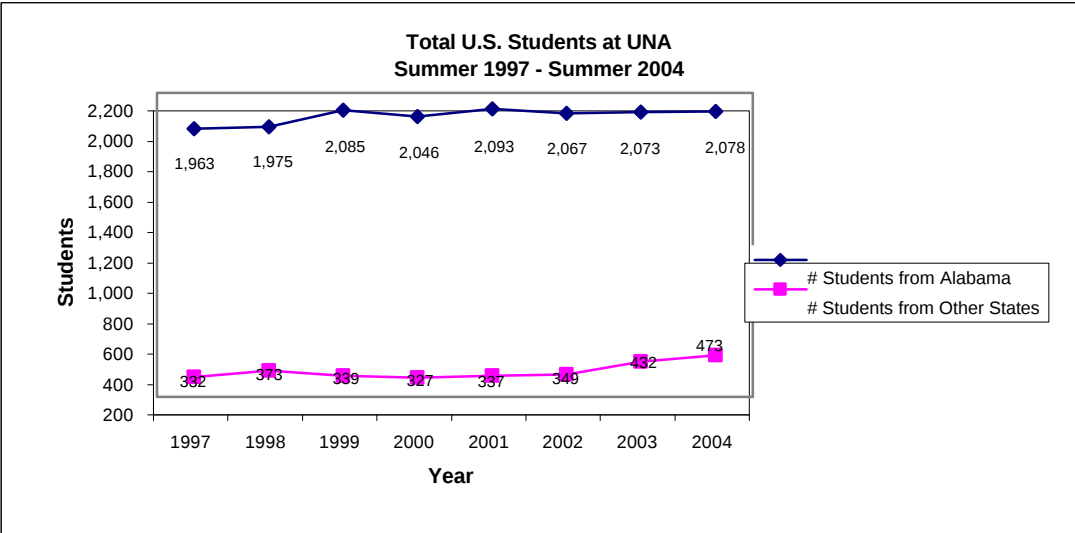
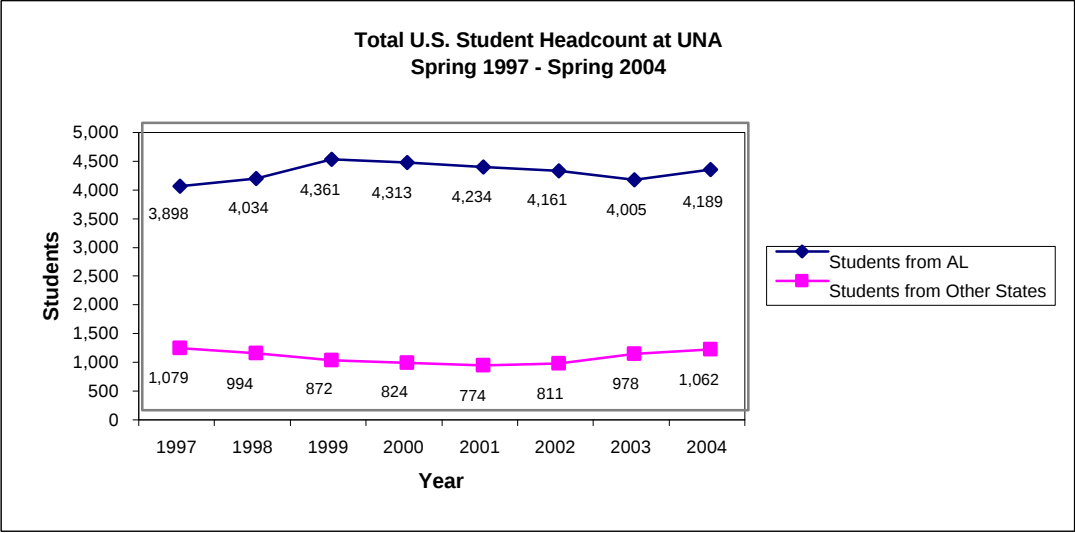
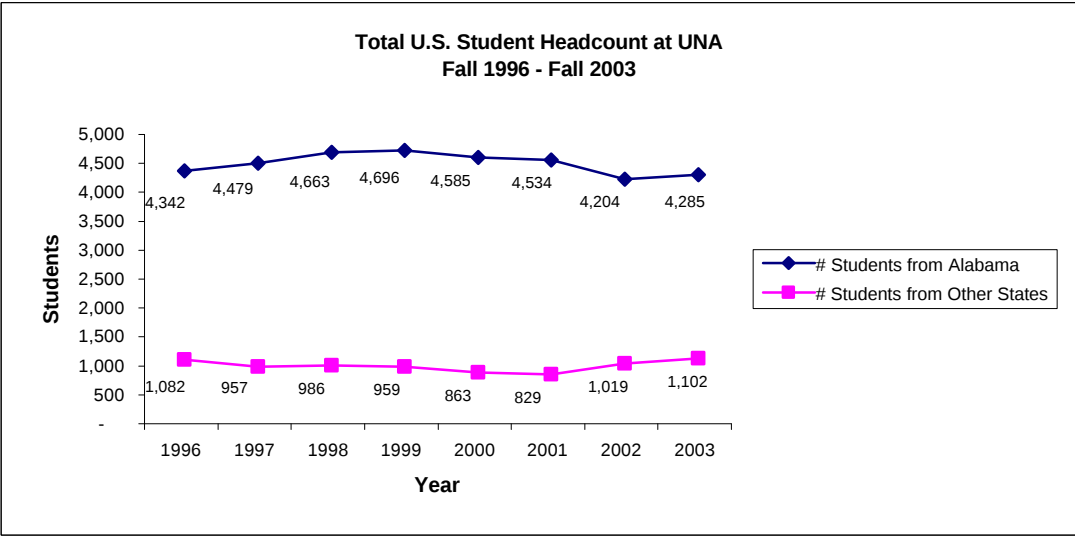


**Total International Students/Countries Represented at UNA

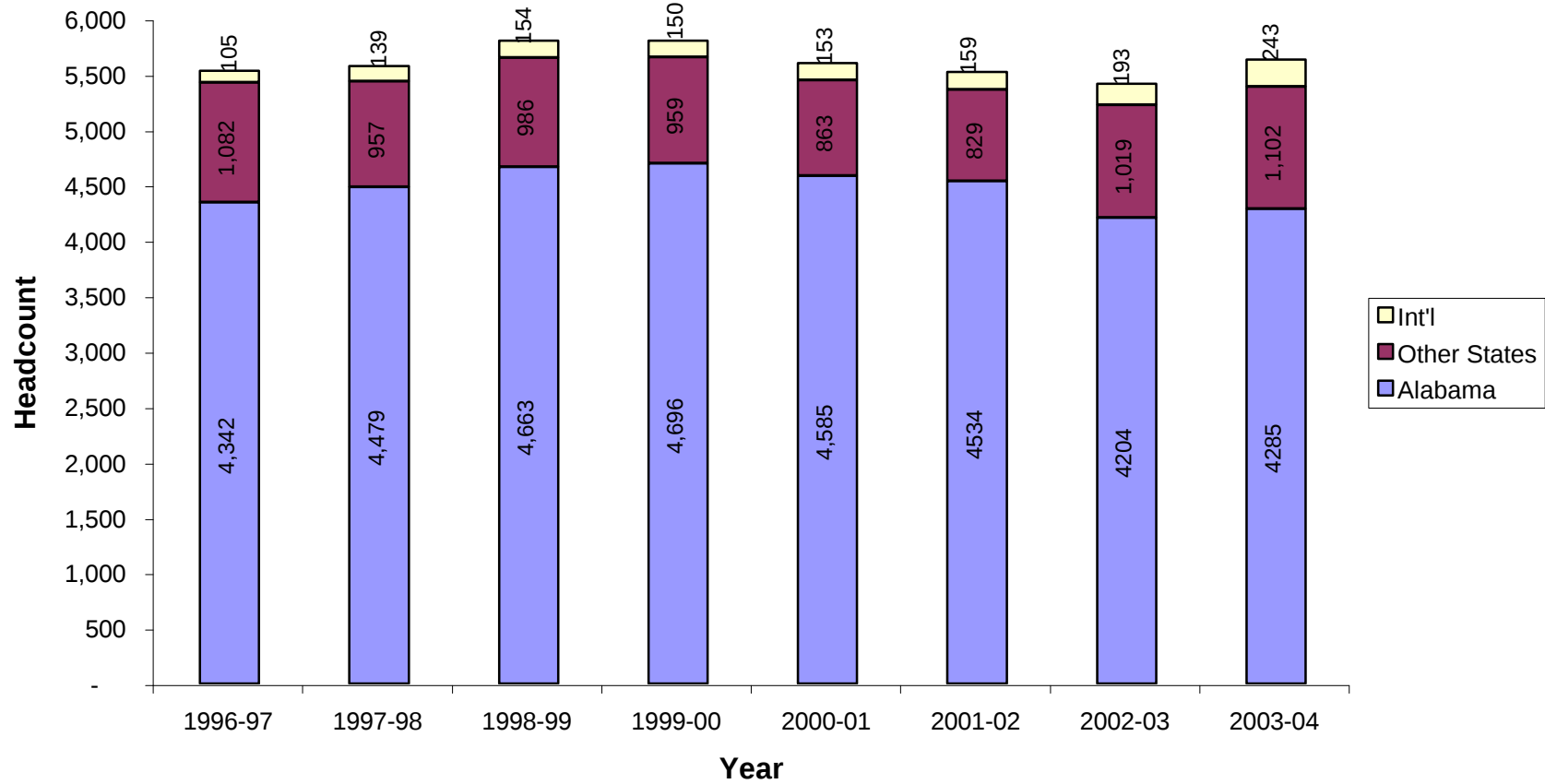

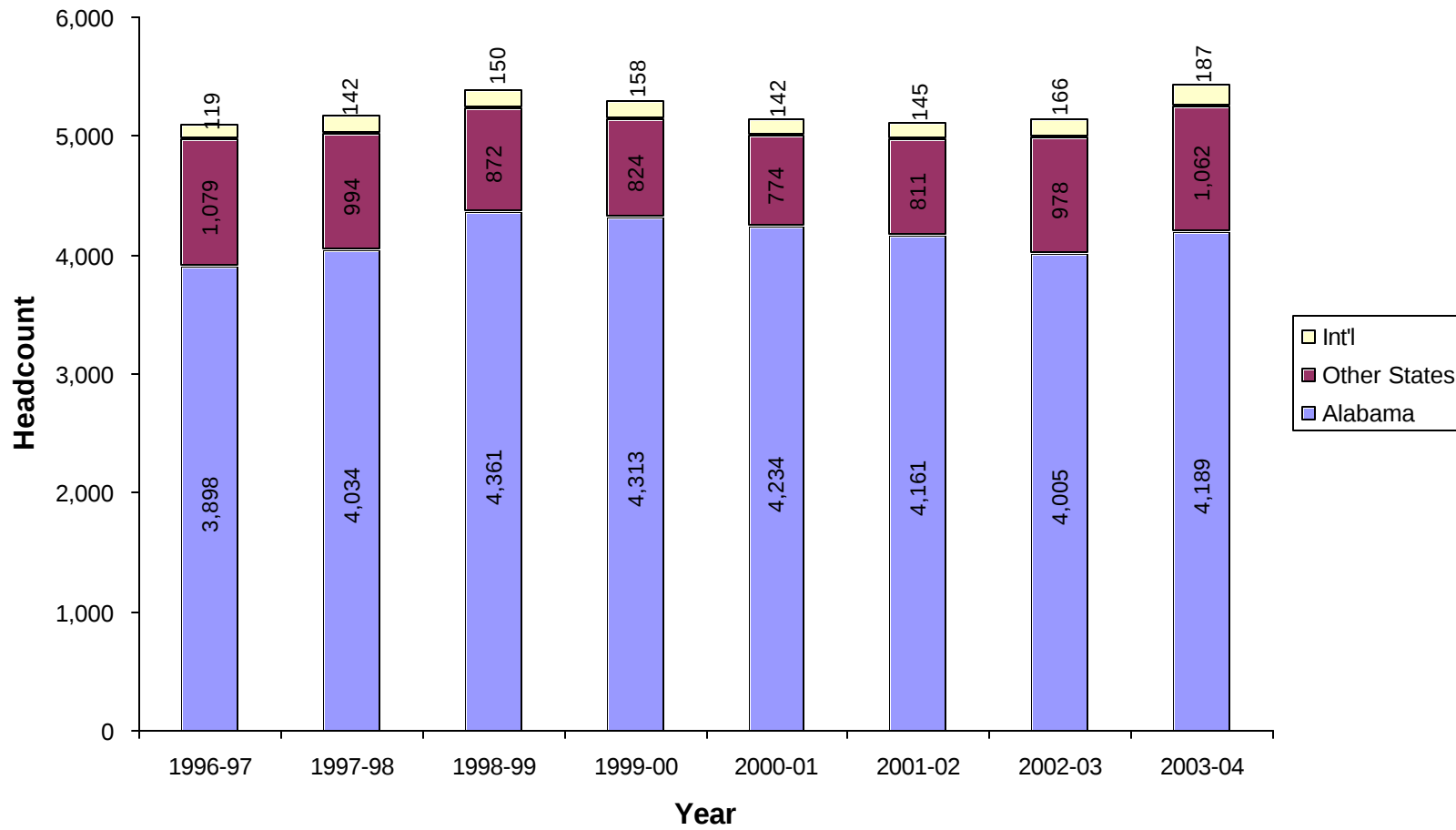

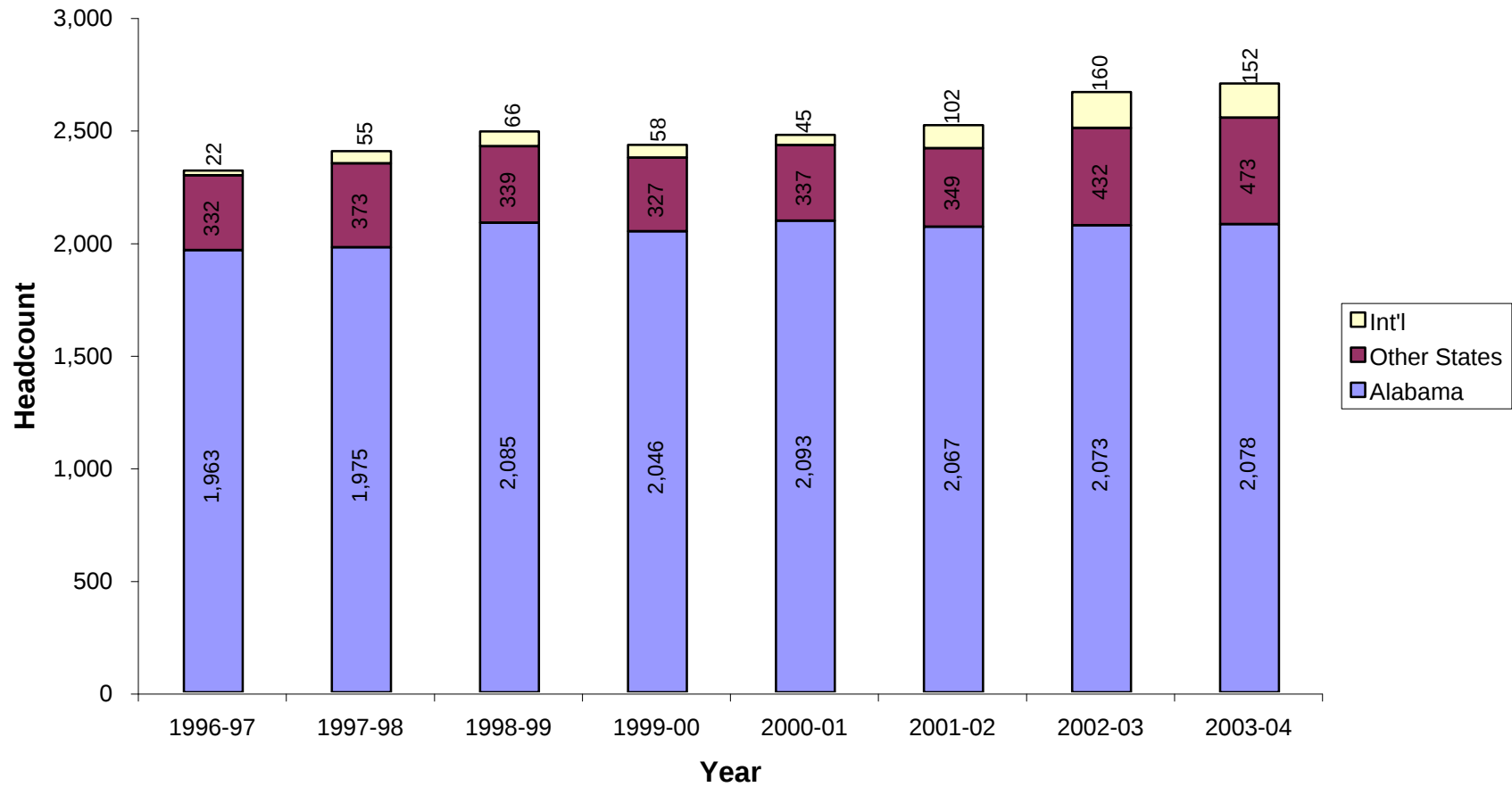
Student Headcount by Source Fall 1996 - Fall 2003



Student Headcount by Source Spring 1997 - Spring 2004

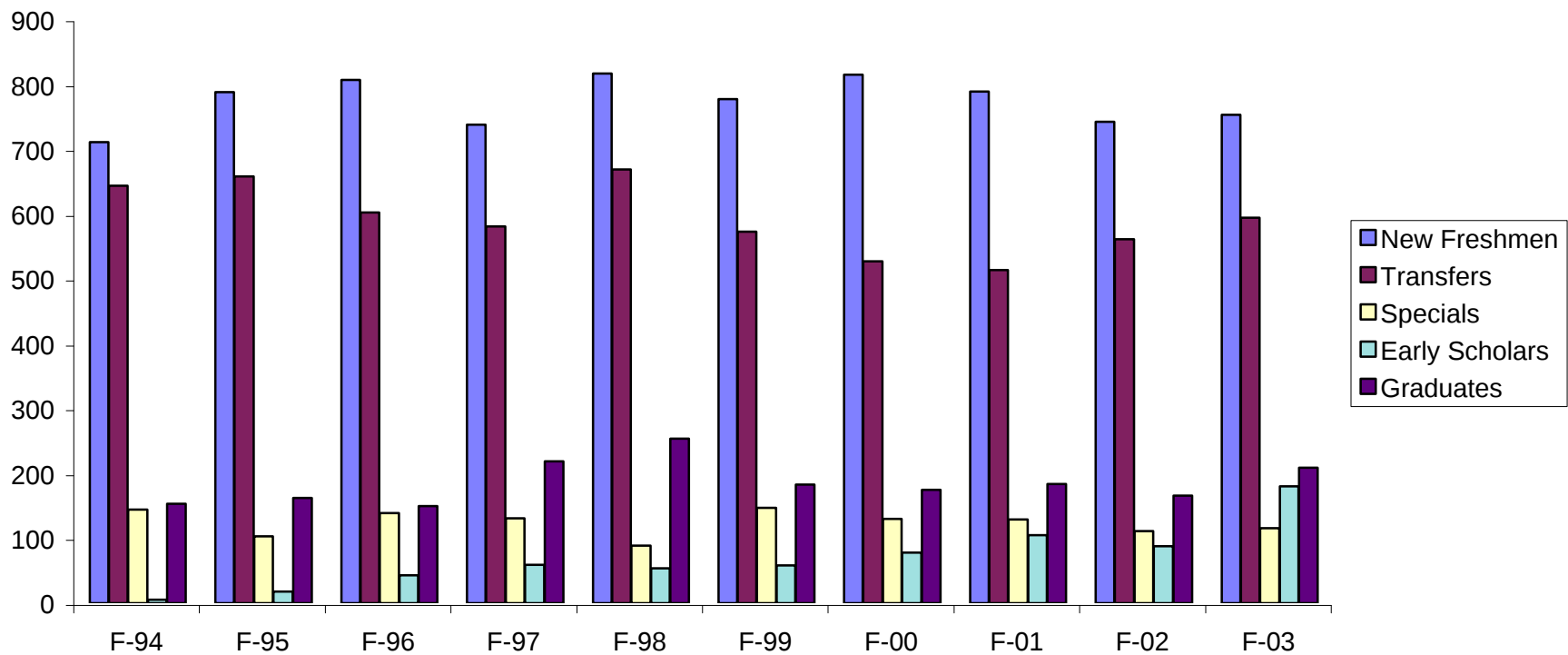


Student Headcount by Source Summer 1997 - Summer 2004

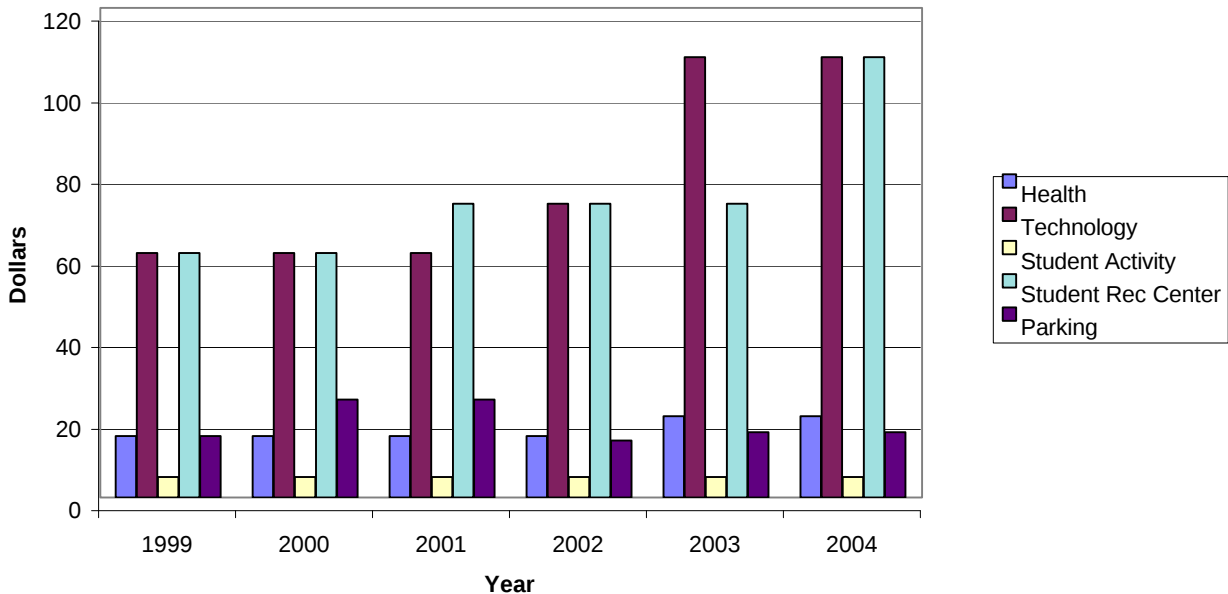

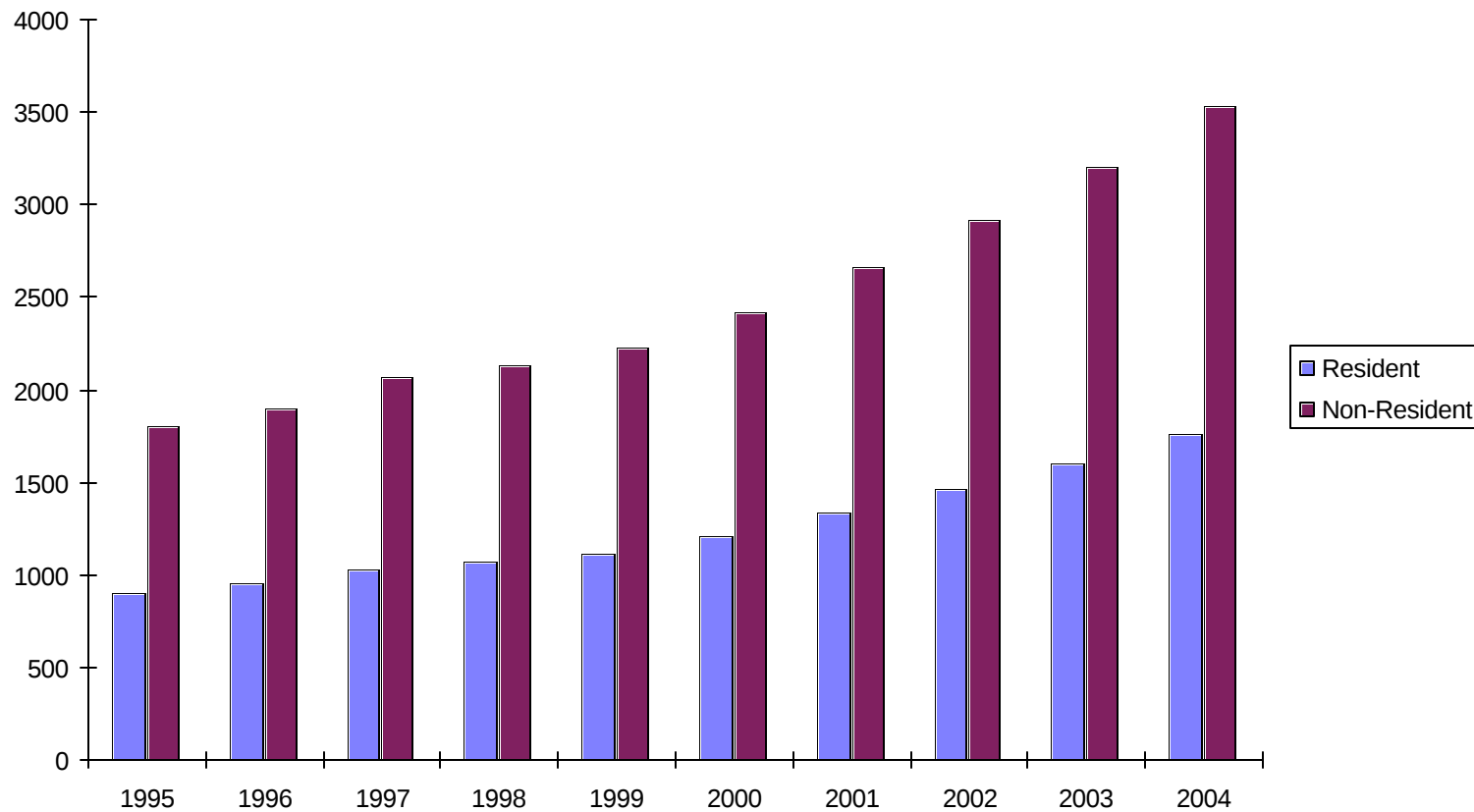
Undergraduate Fees 1999-2004



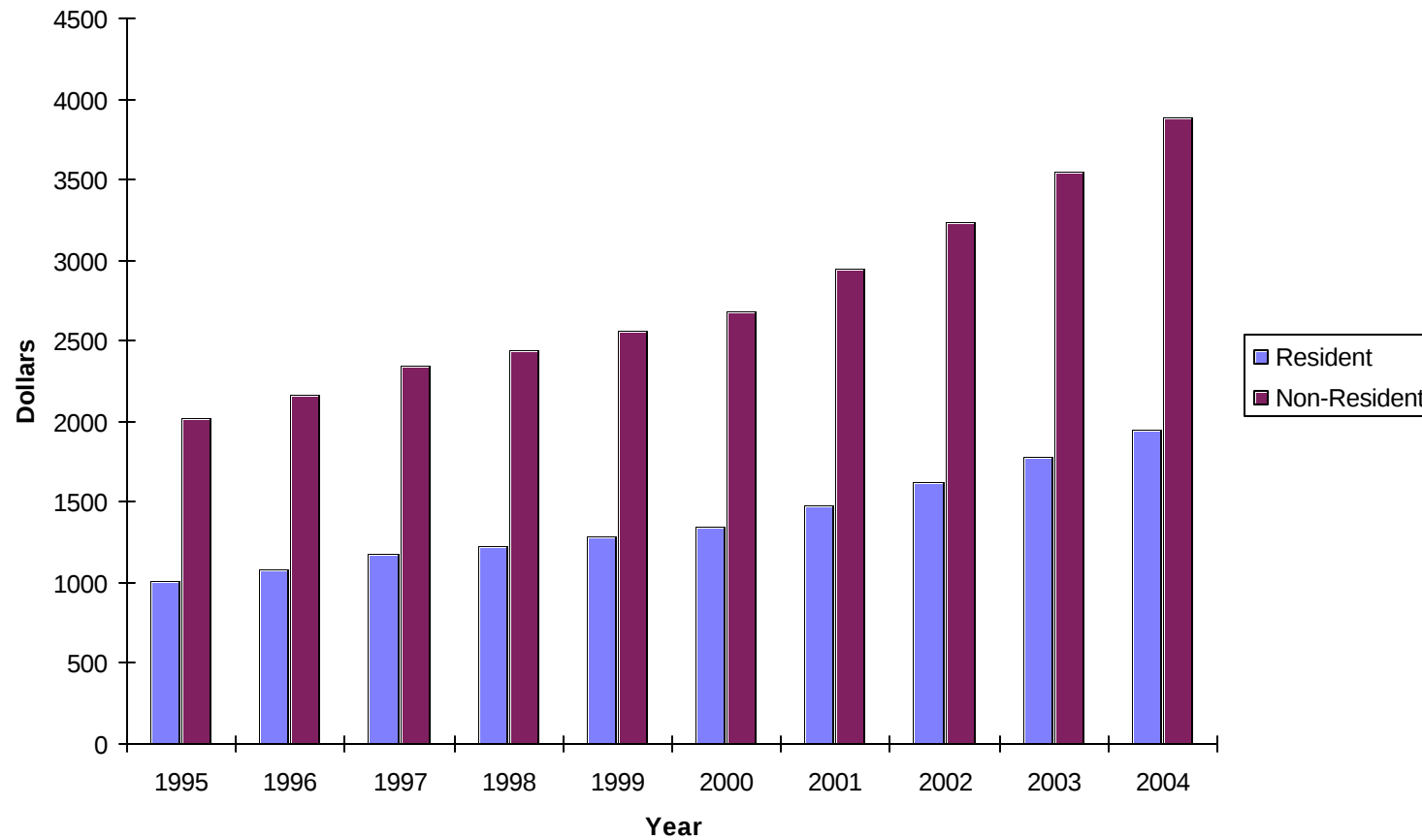
Graduate Fees 1999-2004
