

**Food Services Committee**  
**Meeting Notes**

Tuesday, March 11, 2014

The meeting was called to order at approximately 1:35 p.m. by Chair Ogun. Voting members attending were Peggy Bergeron, Laura Giles, Joy Mallard, and David Shields; non-voting member present was Gwen Turner. There was not a quorum of seven members to approve minutes from November 2013.

New business to be discussed was tabled until next meeting. Gwen Turner, Sodexo, will address items #3, #4, and #5; the vending items #1 and #2 will need to be addressed to the Mane Card office. Laura Giles commented that the Coke machines with Mane card swipe were introduced before current machines that do not have it. Older student population expected a card swipe on vending and had money on card for vending purposes.

Starbucks will remain open for Spring Break but not Chic-Fil-A. Starbucks will be open for summer.

Chair Ogun would like to poll the committee members to see if another date/time would allow better attendance for a quorum. We will have next meeting at East Campus and have a meeting lunch by Chef Ogun.

For April meeting, we will have updates from Sodexo (Gwen Turner) and results from survey.
