

Safety & Emergency Committee Meeting

- I. - II. The committee approved today's agenda and minutes from the [September 17, 2025, meeting](#) by acclamation.
- III. Annual Tasks
 - a. Four emergency drills are set for this academic year, per Fire Marshal guidelines.
 - i. An early Fall semester fire drill has already taken place.
 - ii. A tornado drill will happen in February.
 - iii. A shelter-in-place drill will be near the end of the Fall semester following a discussion with Housing & Residence Life and Student Affairs on the best times.
 - iv. A fire drill will take place in during the Spring semester.
 - b. Chief will work on subcommittees to review emergency procedures and UNA Emergency Manual.
 - i. Security camera subcommittee to meet Oct. 23 – Mr. Humphres said it will meet with HRL's Jayson Jackson, discuss placements at Bank Independent Stadium and LaGrange Hall once they are online, and camera functionality, etc.
 - c. FEMA ICS certificates 100, 200, 700 are currently inaccessible online.
- IV. Lion Alert 360 app
 - a. Please test the new Lion Alert 360 app. This is active for 90 days. Do not share with anyone else as there are limited licenses. Below are instructions for the Apple Testing Link for the app.

 - c. Download TestFlight from the Apple store.
 - d. Click this link from your device <https://testflight.apple.com/join/BPQK3fJt>.
 - e. Once in Lion Alert 360 app, you will login with SSO (UNA credentials).
 - f. Chief will give a briefing to EC on Monday before pushing it out to campus.
 - g. Ms. Eubanks will handle marketing of the app.
 - h. Current Lion Alert users will be rolled over to the new system via email addresses only.
 - i. Current Lion Alert users must add their own phone numbers.
