A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- I. This Act shall be known and cited as the Collegiate Legislature Strike Act.
- II. The purpose of this bill is to strike Chapter 609 from the Code of Laws, seeing that the Collegiate Legislature organization, also known as CLEG, has been dissolved.
- III. 609 currently reads:

Chapter 609 Collegiate Legislature

609.1 The school representative is to be selected annually at the CLEG conference by the current delegation. SGA members must have attended the CLEG conference at least once to be eligible for the school representative position.

609.2 The school representative will coordinate to meet all deadlines and bill submissions for the conference.

609.3 All applications shall be released to SGA members no later than a month before the applications and contracts are due for the “early bird special” deadline, if the “early bird special” is offered. If it is not offered, then the applications are to be released one month before applications are due.


609.4 First preference for selection will be given to Senators and Freshman Forum members. Students at large may fill a spot in the event of a vacancy.

609.5 In the event a student is unable to attend the CLEG conference for any reason, then that student shall be responsible for finding a replacement to go in their place. If said student is unable to find a replacement to go in their place, then they will be responsible for repaying the expenses incurred by the SGA to the SGA Treasurer by the end of the semester.

609.6 The SGA Treasurer along with the SGA Executive council shall be responsible for reporting a lack of payment to the Center for Student Engagement, and a hold will be placed on the student's registration.

IV. Chapter 609 now shall be stricken from the Code of Laws.


V. This bill will become law upon ratification by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the University of North Alabama Student Government Association Senate and the subsequent approval of the Student Government Association President and Vice President.
