- I. This Act shall be known and cited as the Academic Affairs Committee Representing All Amendment Act.
- II. The purpose of this bill is to amend the Code of Laws Section 602.1 to clarify that members of the Academic Affairs committee will be assigned to represent a different college on campus.
- III. Section 602.1 currently reads:
The Academic Affairs Committee shall be composed of no less than three (3) members from the Student Senate, including the chairperson, who shall serve on the Shared Governance Undergraduate Curriculum Committee. Each member of the Academic Affairs Committee shall represent a different college on campus.
- IV. Section 602.1 now shall read:
The Academic Affairs Committee shall be composed of no less than three (3) members from the Student Senate, including the chairperson, who shall serve on the Shared Governance Undergraduate Curriculum Committee. Each member of the Academic Affairs Committee shall be assigned to represent a different college on campus.
- V. This bill will become law upon ratification by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the University of North Alabama Student Government Association Senate and the subsequent approval of the Student Government Association President and Vice President.
