A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- I. This Act shall be known and cited as Freshman Forum Numerical Act.
 - II. The purpose of this bill is to update the code of laws to keep it in line with the constitution on Freshman Forum Clerk and Executive Chair.
 - III. 800.2 currently reads:

The Freshman Forum shall be composed of no more than forty (40) students of freshman classification who have neither completed more than one semester at the University of North Alabama nor more than thirty-one (31) semester hours of credit.
 - IV. 800.2 now shall read:

The Freshman Forum shall be composed of no less than 30, no more than 40 students. Must be a first-time, full-time Freshman at the University of North Alabama. Students who are classified as Sophomores, Juniors, or Seniors due to dual enrollment or college credit earned in high school prior to enrolling to University of North Alabama are still considered eligible. The student must fill out an application to serve on Freshman Forum.
 - V. This bill will become law upon ratification by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the University of North Alabama Student Government Association Senate and the subsequent approval of the Student Government Association President and Vice President.
