A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- I. This Act shall be known and cited as the Not Changing the Absenteeism Policy Act.
- II. The purpose of this bill is to amend the Code of Laws Chapter 200 to specify that this absenteeism policy shall be solely for the Executive and Legislative Branches of the SGA. The attendance and absenteeism policy for the Judicial branch is outlined in Code of Laws Title XI, and there will be further legislation specifying the Freshman Forum absenteeism policy should this bill pass.
- III. 200.1 currently reads:

Absences totaling four (4) per semester from any SGA related meeting shall be grounds for dismissal of a member from their respective branch of SGA. These four (4) per semester absences are inclusive of the respective branch meetings, committee chair meetings, and standing committee meetings.
- IV. 200.1 now shall read:

Absences totaling four (4) per semester from any SGA related meeting shall be grounds for dismissal of a member from the Executive or Legislative branches of SGA. These four (4) per semester absences are inclusive of the Senate meetings, Executive council meetings, committee chair meetings, and standing committee meetings.
- V. 200.8 currently reads:

Tardiness to SGA meetings shall be grounds for dismissal from the SGA members' respective branch. Three (3) tardies shall equal one (1) absence. Tardy shall be defined as entering the chambers after the last name is called during the Roll Call portion of the Agenda.
- VI. 200.8 now shall read:

Tardiness to Senate meetings and/or Executive Council meetings shall be grounds for dismissal from the Executive or Legislative branches. Three (3) tardies shall equal one (1) absence. Tardy shall be defined as entering the chambers and/or Executive Council meeting after the last name is called during the Roll Call portion of the Agenda.

VII. This legislation shall go into effect on August 1, 2026

VIII. This bill will become law upon ratification by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the University of North Alabama Student Government Association Senate and the subsequent approval of the Student Government Association President and Vice President.


