A BILL ENTITLED TO BE AN ACT

- I. This Act shall be known and cited as the Diversity and Inclusion Obligations Act.
- II. The purpose of this bill is to amend Chapter 3000 of the Code of Laws pertaining to the position and obligations tasked to the SGA Diversity and Inclusion Advocate (DIA).
- III. Chapter 3000 currently reads:

3000.1

The position shall oversee the SGA Registered Student Organization (RSO) outreach initiative.

3000.1.1

The outreach initiative shall consist of senators reaching out to RSOs at least once per academic year in order to learn more about the needs and concerns of the RSO. They shall report back to the DIA, and the DIA shall communicate RSO feedback to the Senate.

3000.2

Communicate with the Division of Student Affairs concerning Local, State, and National Legislation that may affect the campus community.

3000.3

Work with the Chair of the Student Welfare committee in order to orchestrate an event for the campus community.

3000.4

Ensure a safe and welcoming campus for all students at the University of North Alabama.

- IV. Chapter 3000 now shall read:

3000.1

The position shall oversee the SGA Registered Student Organization (RSO) outreach initiative.

3000.1.1

The outreach initiative shall consist of the DIA reaching out to RSOs at least once per academic year in order to learn more about the needs and concerns of the RSO. The DIA shall then communicate RSO feedback to the Senate.

3000.2

Communicate with the Diversity of Student Affairs concerning Local, State, and National Legislation that may affect the campus community.

3000.3

Work with the Chair of the Student Welfare committee in order to orchestrate at least one event for the campus community.

3000.4

Orchestrate at least one collaborative campus wide event for students each semester.

3000.4.1

The collaborative events must involve at least one campus organization or that actively promotes diversity and inclusion.


3000.5


Communicate with International Affairs to assist with developing and implementing ideas that could enhance students' wellbeing on campus.

3000.6


Ensure a safe and welcoming campus for all students at the University of North Alabama.


