A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

I. This Act shall be known and cited as The Officers Rules Test Act.

II. The purpose of this bill is to amend Code of Laws Chapter 100 to establish a clear timeline and maximum attempt limits for the mandatory knowledge test required of all SGA Executive Officers.

III. 100.3 currently reads:

100.3 To score a 90% or better on a general knowledge written test concerning the SGA Constitution, Code of Laws, and Parliamentary Procedure. Failure to meet this requirement shall result in immediate dismissal. A President, Vice President, Secretary, and/or Treasurer who does not pass the test on the first attempt may appeal to the SGA Senate and shall be allowed to attempt the test again upon 2/3 approval of the SGA Senate present.

IV. 100.3 now shall read:

100.3 To score a ninety percent (90%) or better on a general knowledge written test concerning the SGA Constitution, Code of Laws, and Parliamentary Procedure, administered by the Judicial Branch. This test must be completed within four (4) consecutive Senate meetings following the first fall Senate meeting of the academic year.

V. 100.3.1 now shall read:

100.3.1 Failure to meet the above-mentioned requirements of the general knowledge written test shall result in dismissal from their executive office. A dismissed officer may appeal to the SGA Senate, and, upon a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of Senators, shall be permitted to attempt the test again. An officer shall be allowed for a maximum of one (1) additional attempt. Failure to achieve a passing score after both attempts have been exhausted shall result in permanent dismissal from their executive office for that term.

VI. This bill will become law upon ratification by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the University of North Alabama Student Government Association Senate and the subsequent approval of the Student Government Association President and Vice President.
