A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

I. This Act shall be known and cited as The Judicial Rules Test Act.

II. The purpose of this bill is to amend Code of Laws Chapter 900 to establish a clear timeline and procedures for the Senate Rules test administered by the Judicial Branch.

III. 900.3 currently reads:

900.3 The Senate test will be created and approved by the Judicial Branch and shall be administered and graded by two justices, neither of which serve as Chief Justice.

IV. 900.3 now shall read:

900.3 The Judicial Branch shall create and approve the general knowledge written test concerning the SGA Constitution, Code of Laws, and Parliamentary Procedure. The Judicial Branch shall announce the test date no later than the first fall Senate meeting of the year, and the test must be administered within the first four (4) consecutive Senate meetings of the year. In the case of a Senator being sworn in late or sworn in on or after the officially scheduled test day, the Judicial Branch shall administer the test within four (4) consecutive Senate meetings of their swearing-in date. The test shall be administered and graded by two (2) Justices, neither of whom shall serve as Chief Justice.

V. This bill will become law upon ratification by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the University of North Alabama Student Government Association Senate and the subsequent approval of the Student Government Association President and Vice President.
