- I. This Act shall be known and cited as Dress Code Act.
- II. The purpose of this bill is to make a new section that amends the Code of Laws concerning the dress code. This new section will present a clearer and more understandable section for senators. This will give senators a chance to have more control of what they should wear and what is formal and not formal. This new section will help eliminate any cultural insensitivities and socio-economic status issues when it comes to what a Senator should wear. The decision shall not be based off of one person's perspective, but the Senate as a whole.
- III. Currently reads:  
  
200.4 SGA members are required to wear appropriate attire that shall be deemed and regulated by the Vice President of the branch.
- IV. Now to read:  
  
Chapter 201 Dress Code  
  
201.1 SGA members are required to wear appropriate attire that shall be deemed and regulated by the Vice President of the branch with the ratification by two-thirds (2/3) of the SGA Senate. Senate shall have an input on the attire for what Senators should and should not wear.
- V. This bill will become law upon the ratification by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the University of North Alabama Student Government Association Senate, and its subsequent approval by the Student Government Association President and Vice-President.
