## STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT Bill 23-03

## Written by Senator Will Driver September 7, 2023

- I. This Act shall be known and cited as Freshman and Transfer Senator Constitutional Changes.
- II. The purpose of this bill is to amend Article III, Section 5 of the University of North Alabama Student Government Association Constitution.
- III. Article III, Section 5 currently reads: Their enrollment proportions shall decide representation for every degree granting college for every 500 students based on enrollment numbers from the previous spring semester. A college shall be granted an additional senate seat once they have an additional enrollment of at least 300 of their next 500 students.
- IV. Now it shall read: Their enrollment proportions shall decide representation for every degree granting college based on enrollment numbers from the previous spring semester. An Ad-Hoc committee shall be formed and consist of the Elections and Recruitment Chairperson, and at least four senators, one from each Academic College, to reevaluate the established number of senators and to alter this number if necessary.

V. This bill will become law upon the ratification by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the University of North Alabama Student Government Association Senate, and its subsequent approval by the Student body by a referendum vote.
