STAFF SPOTLIGHT --UNA CAMPUS COALITION FOR BASIC NEEDS



Earlier this fall, Holly Edens and Bethany Green travelled to Auburn, AL on behalf of the UNA Campus Coalition for Basic Needs Task Force to receive a \$25,000 grant from Auburn University Hunger Solutions. UNA's task force is made up of staff and faculty campus wide, including Holly and Bethany. These funds will be used to improve service for our students experiencing food and basic needs insecurity.

UNA joined the Alabama Campus Coalition for Basic Needs (ACCBN) in 2019, at its inception, along with 9 other four-year universities. The coalition has since grown to include 13 four-year and 12 two-year colleges across the state. The mission of the ACCBN is to unify colleges and universities throughout Alabama to ensure student basic needs are met, thereby empowering all students to succeed in school, earn degrees, and open doors to opportunity.
