# 2024 UNA Marching Pride Auxiliary Auditions Saturday, March 16, 2024

### **Audition Requirements**

- 1. **UNA Color Guard** candidates must have experience as a performing member within their high school color guard.
- 2. **UNA Lionette** candidates must have experience as a performing member within their high school dance line, studio dance team, or their high school cheer squad.
- 3. **UNA Majorette** candidates must have experience as a performing member within their high school majorette line.
- 4. All candidates must submit a completed tryout packet before the in-person audition on **March 16, 2024,** to be eligible for Round 2.

#### **Audition Process**

#### **Round 1: Online Video Submission**

All candidates must submit two videos – a skills video and the UNA Fight Song routine. See specific Round 1 requirements for each auxiliary unit by clicking on the appropriate bookmark at the bottom of this page.

#### **Round 2: In-person Group Routine Audition**

Finalists from Round 1 who advance to Round 2 will receive an email on **Wednesday, March 13, 2024.** The email will include an instructional video of the group routine for the Round 2 audition. This group routine will be reviewed (not taught) during our auxiliary clinic on **Friday, March 15, 2024,** which will begin at 6:00 p.m. in the <u>Student Recreation Center</u>. Candidates are highly encouraged to attend the audition clinic, but participation in the clinic is not required for Round 2. Tryout requirements will be reviewed during the clinic session.

Recommended attire for the clinic session is as follows: shorts, a sleeveless shirt, and tennis shoes. Candidates auditioning for Color Guard must bring their own 6ft pole and silk.

Please be mindful that the clinic and Round 2 auditions are closed to the public. A waiting space will be made available for family members and guests.

Appearance will be judged in video and in-person auditions. Hair, makeup, and jewelry should be of performance quality. No jewelry except stud earrings.

  - o pas de bouree (right and left)
  - o high kicks (right and left) to the 45 and the front
  - fan kicks (right and left)
  - o 2 sets of straight 8 kicks, and 2 sets of Rockette kicks
  - o 30 second split hold (right only)

• Round 2 (Solo Routine): All candidates can wear a 2-piece outfit of their choice. It is important to make sure the outfit is appropriate and will not get in the way of your performance. Appearance will be judged in video and in-person auditions. Hair, makeup, and jewelry should be of performance quality. No jewelry except stud earrings.

#### **Round 2: Solo Routine**

• For candidates advancing to Round 2, a group routine will be required. The group routine will be provided via email and reviewed at the clinic session. A solo twirl routine will also be required. The solo twirl routine should include personal style, which shows the candidate's abilities in creativity, difficulty, and execution. You may choose any music that is tasteful. Your routine must be 2-3 minutes in length. Please bring your musical selection on CD, phone, or send the music to the captains (email addresses provided below).
